FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR



Every so often I like to update y'all on the state of the parish and the good things we're doing here. We have a lot to be proud of at St. Elizabeth, and I'm writing to you now to ask for your help in sustaining us in our mission and keeping us strong.

We're blessed with some great groups here at the parish. The Altar Guild supports many aspects of the parish relating to the worship of God in the Liturgy, as do our three choirs with sacred music. The Guadalupanas Association and the Knights of Columbus support other aspects of our community life, and always step up when called upon. Our Society of St. Vincent de Paul leads the way in assistance to the needy in our area.

In the area of faith formation and Christian initiation, we have about 175 students receiving formation in one form or another at the parish (not including the students at our School, all of whom receive daily religious formation), and about 115 total preparing to receive one or more sacrament of initiation, not including infant baptisms. Thanks to all who help make this possible, especially our terrific volunteers!

You'll also notice we continue to make repairs and improvements to our physical campus to make it safer and more welcoming. I'm especially proud that we've restored power to the lamp-posts out front, and are working to install a commercial-grade glass door in Grahmann. Projects like these — not to mention fixing the Granite Arch and the parking lot over the last 12 months — along with regular upkeep like HVAC repairs and keeping the trees properly trimmed, are only able to happen because of your ongoing financial support.

In taking on some of these projects, however, we've had to dip into our reserves a bit, even while 'tightening the belt' when it comes to other operating expenditures. More alarmingly, we have also recently experienced a fairly substantial drop in our offertory collection, perhaps because the needs of the parish are not well known. For this reason, I earnestly request that you consider increasing your support for our Parish, especially as you consider year-end giving and budget for the new year. You play an important role in helping this parish thrive.

Our parish Health Ministry will be hosting a Carter Blood Drive activity set for **November 12, from 9:00 AM until 2:00 PM**. There is a **sign-up sheet in the rear of the church this weekend**. Your community blood supply is experiencing its most prolonged period of a critical shortage in recent history. All blood types are needed, desperately, from all eligible blood donors. Hospital patients are in jeopardy of not receiving the transfusions they require and hospital executives are monitoring day-to-day their ability to provide a full scope of services, based on the day's blood inventory.
