Third Sunday of Advent

FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR



With Gaudete (“Rejoice!”) Sunday, and the beginning of the “O Antiphons” in the Liturgy of the Hours, our joyful expectation and immediate preparation for Christmas intensifies.

This year Christmas falls on a Monday, meaning Christmas Eve falls on a Sunday. Some of y’all might be wondering: if I go to

Mass on Christmas Eve, can that count for both towards the Sunday and Christmas?

The short answer is: No. Two obligations means you’ll need to attend two Masses to fulfill them. Usually when a holy day of obligation falls on a Saturday or a Monday, the obligation is lifted, but not so for Christmas, because it’s such a significant feast. It’s important to attend Mass when the Church asks us to, namely: on all Sundays and holy days of obligation. This is one of the basic ways we show Jesus we love Him. To miss Mass on one of these days without a serious reason is a grave sin.

Having said this, you have some options as to how you fulfill your Mass obligations. We’re keeping our regular Sunday Mass schedule, so you can attend whichever Sunday (or Saturday evening) Mass you normally attend, followed by whichever Christmas Mass you normally attend. If that means attending two Masses on Sunday — for example: 8 am and 11 pm; or noon and 4pm — that’s perfectly fine! Or you could attend 5pm on Saturday and 10am on Monday, that would be fine too.

You could even attend two Masses on Sunday evening, even though the prayers at the Masses will be for Christmas, not for Sunday. The reason for this is that it’s still Sunday on Sunday evening, even if it’s also Christmas Eve. But remember: two obligations means two Masses. Those are the rules.
