From the Desk of the Parochial Vicar



Your will be done, Lord

The Penny Catechism of the Catholic Church affirms that the chief powers of the soul are the memory, the understanding, and the will (no. 30). The will is the faculty by which a person decides to

perform an action out of conviction and motivation. On this, many theological and psychological studies agree that the will is the most difficult faculty to influence in human person. A story was told of a young boy who was asked by his father to kneel for insulting an elder. The boy, while obeying his father, retorted: "though I am kneeling in your eyes, in my mind I am standing up". It shows the absence of the will, on the part of the boy, in carrying out the punishment. So, obedience to God requires total abandonment of our will to God's will.

In the first reading, David wanted to build a house for God, but God's will for David was not for him to build him a house but to establish his throne forever. David gave up his will for God's will to be done and for fulfillment of God's promises.

In the gospel reading, God's promise to David was fulfilled when the angel Gabriel visited Mary. Mary accepted God's will for her to embody the word and to remain a virgin, even though she was already betrothed to Joseph. Mary's acceptance of the will of God is seen in her fiat: "I am the handmaid of the Lord let it be done to me according to your will".

David and Mary serve as examples for us to emulate. Mary's response facilitated God's plan of salvation. Through our cooperation with God's will, he will do marvelous things in and through us, as he did in and through the lives of David and Mary. We only need to give God a chance by learning and obeying his will for us through his word and the Church. As the advent season comes to an end, it is important to hold firm to the spiritual fruits of the season and continue to live according to good resolutions we made this season.

May God, through the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, help us to do his will and witness with joy the presence of Christ among us (Emmanuel) whose food was only to do the will of the father who sent him.
