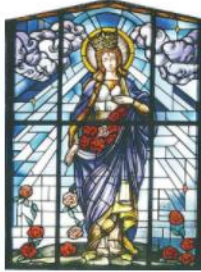

The Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR



As we've concluded the Christmas Season and await the beginning of Lent — in just one month! — we find ourselves back in the “green season” of Ordinary Time. In much the same way as the other seasons, Ordinary Time follows a progression: beginning with the first events of Jesus' public ministry, through His teaching & miracles throughout the summer, to the parables on the end times in the fall.

This week and next, our Gospel passages recount the calling of the Apostles. This was one of the first steps in our Lord's public ministry, and it's worth recalling that the Apostles accompanied Him throughout, for roughly three years, before His Passion. Jesus invested time — and much patience! — in these men who would be entrusted with carrying on His mission. Even when we don't see them mentioned in events recounted in the Gospel, they're likely present and being formed.

Today's first reading recounts the call of Samuel, one of the great prophets in Israel's history. It's one of my favorites, as it shows a young man learning to hear and discern the voice of the Lord. “Speak, for your servant is listening” is a great way to begin a period of prayer.

We can see the wisdom of pairing today's first reading with the Gospel passage, as both recount a first encounter with the Lord, and the beginning of an extraordinary calling. I am confident that the Lord still calls people in similar ways. Indeed, both of these accounts resonate greatly with my own experience of being called to the priesthood.

Let's be attentive to the way our Lord is still calling His people. That begins with taking time in prayer to listen for His voice. We should also be encouraging young people — especially from among our families — to listen for the call to become a priest or religious sister, and encourage them to respond generously if they hear it.

Next Sunday Fr. Mark Garrett, the Director of Vocations for the Diocese, will celebrate the 10 am Mass here at St. Elizabeth. He is the primary contact for young men responding to God's call to the priesthood. Please give him a warm welcome, and pray for vocations!

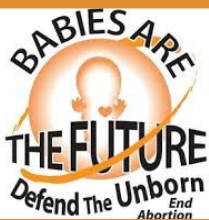


Catholic Charities Mobile Food Pantry in partnership with St. Vincent de Paul Food Distribution
