The First Sunday of Lent

From the Desk of the Parochial Vicar



Lent: A Time to Put our **Baptismal Grace at Work**

The story of Noah and the ark, in today's 1st reading, is a remarkable story that recounts the merciful love of God. God made a covenant with Noah that never will he destroy the earth again

with a flood. The bow in the cloud became the sign of the covenant. The saving of Noah and his household through the great flood has a symbolic meaning. For just as Noah and his household were saved through water, so we are saved through the waters of baptism.

St. Peter points out, in the 2nd reading, how Noah's episode prefigured baptism. God's patience, according to him, waited in the days of Noah during the building of the ark; and through water God saved Noah and his family. Baptism, therefore, corresponds to this because it saves us not as a removal of bodily dirt but through the salvific event of Christ's death and resurrection. The sign of baptism now overtakes the sign of the bow in the cloud, which marks a total renewal and triumph over sin.

The temptation of Jesus by the devil after his baptism, and his victory over the devil reveal to us that baptism gives us all the graces to conquer every temptation. In this sense, temptations become avenues for putting God's grace at work and means of showing: i) that with God and through our baptism, we are stronger than the tempter; ii) that we are not becoming conceited over having God's gifts; iii) the proof that we have completely renounced the devil and sin; iv) that by the struggle we are becoming even stronger; and v) the immensity of the precious gift of grace we received at baptism.

This period of lent gives us yet another opportunity to resist the tempter in every way through the power of our Christian baptism, recognizing that we possess every grace that we need to battle against him, and renounce him, especially in the sacrament of reconciliation.


