#### From The Desk of The Parochial Vicar

#### The problem of the rich fool



Today, the readings of the Church present us with two complex paradoxes. In the Gospel, Jesus narrates the parable of the rich fool. He tells the story of a man whose land produced a bountiful harvest, and he was

happy with himself and decided to make merry. And God said, 'You fool, this night your life will be demanded of you.' On a superficial level, it is difficult to tell what the offence of this diligent man was. Does God despise hard work or is he angry that a man who had worked hard is enjoying the fruit of his labor? The second paradox is found in the first reading from the book of Ecclesiastes. Referring to material possessions, it says 'vanity upon vanities! All things are vanity!' You cannot but wonder if there is anything wrong with having material possessions. Don't we need these material possessions to live our lives on earth? Does the Bible condemn ownership of private property upon which modern civilization is built?

Unfortunately, without proper interpretation, it is easy to misread these passages as saying that God is against material prosperity or affluence or richness or maybe that God wants us to suffer. This is not true. In fact, the evidence of the Bible tells us that God has super rich friends starting from Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, David and so on. According to the theology of the body by St. Pope John Paul II, the resurrection of Jesus Christ ushered the blessing of prosperity in the body and the soul for us all. The Church teaches that after creation, the command of God to Adam and Eve to dominate the world is at the foundation of the Christian teaching on work, harvest and prosperity. Nothing is wrong with hard work, and nothing is wrong with enjoying the fruits of one's labor.

But the rich fool had some problems. One of them was that he did not understand the assignment. He understood possession to be an end rather than a means to an end, hence, his punishment. When God gives you wealth, a position, platform or skill, he gives you instruments you will use to serve him and instruments that will facilitate your relationship with him. Sufficiency is not a moratorium on God. The fact that you make money through hard work should not lead to the extinction of reliance on divine providence. Little wonder, the second reading advises that we set our hearts on things that are above. Any possession enjoyed as an end is vanity.

So, work hard. Celebrate and enjoy your riches but never forget your God and your soul. God bless you.


