From The Desk of The Pastor

Practical Notes on Receiving Communion



The Eucharist, which we receive in Holy Communion, is the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of our Lord Jesus Christ. Therefore when we receive Him, it is of the utmost importance that we do so well. I'll take this op-

portunity to share some practical notes about this important moment in the Mass.

First, only practicing Catholics in good standing should receive Holy Communion — that is, those who have been properly prepared and initiated, and who are in a state of grace. Sometimes folks who are not Catholic find themselves attending Mass for whatever reason — and that's a good thing! All are welcome to attend Mass. However, at Communion time, they might follow along with what everyone else is doing, and accidentally try to receive Communion when they aren't supposed to. That's why I always try to be alert when distributing Holy Communion, and I'm grateful for your patience if I've ever misjudged your approach and asked "are you Catholic?" or "Do you receive?" if I'm not sure.

Next, we should always fast for at least one hour before receiving Holy Communion. That's one of the reasons why we don't chew gum or consume food or drinks during or immediately before Mass. Neither water nor medicine break the fast, so feel free to take them if you need to. If you're taking a lozenge for medicinal purposes, please do so discreetly to avoid giving other people the impression that you're chewing gum or candy.

Receiving on the tongue, while standing, is the norm for reception of Holy Communion. It is also permitted to receive on the hand in the United States and some other countries, or to receive while kneeling. For those who prefer to kneel, we have altar rails which you're free to use. No need to make eye contact with me beforehand — if you just go to the altar rail, I'll know what to do.

For those who receive on the hand, please make sure to do so in the proper way, with both hands, not grasping the Host before It is placed on your palm, and then consuming It immediately, without making the sign of the cross with It or any other sort of gesture. NEVER break the Host with your hands before consuming — it can lead to particles of the Host falling to the ground.

Holy Day of Obligation



The Assumption of Mary Feast Day dates back to earliest Christian times. The first believed to have asked what had happened to Mary's body was St Epiphanius, a 4th Century bishop who devoted himself to the study of Mary's death and believed Our Lady did not die but instead was recalled to heaven.

The feast day of this holy and momentous event stems from the middle of the 5th Century when the Commemoration of the Mother of God was celebrated each year on 15 August in a shrine located near Jerusa-


lem. More than 100 years later, the feast also commemorated the end of Mary's sojourn on earth and was known as the "Dormition of Our Lady."

The feast was introduced to Rome in the 8th Century by Pope Sergius and from there it spread rapidly throughout western Europe, with Pope Hadrian later giving the Feast Day its official name as the Assumption of Mary towards the end of the Century.

Mass will be celebrated on Thursday, August 14th at 7:00 PM; Friday, August 15th at 8:00 AM, 12:00 PM, and 7:00 PM.


