From The Desk of The Pastor

Practical Notes on Anointing of the Sick



The sacrament of anointing is a great expression of our Lord's love for His suffering people. We read in Scripture: "Is there anyone sick among you? Let him send for the presbyters of the Church and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. The prayer of faith will save the sick man and the Lord will raise him up. If he has committed any sins, they will be forgiven him" (James 5:14-15). I'll offer some practical notes on the anointing of the sick.

The sacrament of anointing is intended for those who have begun to be in danger of death due to illness or old age. One who has suffered a life-threatening injury might also receive anointing. However, it is not intended for all who face life-threatening circumstances. For instance, a soldier going into battle would obviously not be anointed. Nor would one be eligible for anointing who is undergoing surgery to address a non-life-threatening condition. I had surgery on my eyes in high school, and although I was put under general anesthesia — which carries with it certain real dangers — I was not eligible for the sacrament of anointing because the danger came from the procedure itself, not from my condition.

You may have heard this sacrament called the Last Rites, but that can be misleading. The sacrament of anointing is not only for those who are already at the point of dying, but is for those who have begun to be in danger of death. Therefore we shouldn't wait until the last minute to request it if we can avoid it, as it might be difficult or even impossible for a priest to make it in time. Certainly don't wait until after the death to request anointing: the sacraments are only efficacious for the living. One may be anointed multiple times over the course of an illness if the condition worsens significantly or is of a long duration.

We try to make this sacrament available for all who need it, and every parish should have a sacramental emergency line that goes directly to a priest after hours. Ours is posted on our website and the front page of the bulletin, and the chaplaincy departments of most of our local hospitals also have a direct line to a priest to come in case of emergency.

Finally, please know that the Lord is close to those who suffer, because He Himself suffered. The sick and the dying can be powerful intercessors for the Church as the Lord hears their prayers in a special way. Let's pray for them, and may they pray for us!
