From The Desk of The Pastor

Hearing God Calling



I visited our Faith Formation classrooms last Sunday, and as they're getting to know each other we played a game where we went around the room and said our name and some-

thing we love that starts with the first letter of our name. "I'm Father Emmett, and I love the Eucharist!" — didn't have to think too hard about that one. Then I was asked what my favorite Bible passage is, and that's a bit of a tougher question. There are many passages I love, how could I choose just one? I told the class that one of my favorite parts of the Bible is the Calling of Samuel (1 Sam. 3).

The boy Samuel was dedicated for service to the LORD by his mother, Hannah, at a time when the priesthood was in bad shape, and the LORD was rarely heard, and seemed distant. (It's hard to imagine that being a coincidence.) When Samuel was in the sanctuary trying to sleep one evening, he heard a voice calling his name. At first he thought it was the High Priest, Eli, calling him, but after reporting to him a couple of times, Eli realized it was the LORD calling Samuel. So Eli told him "Go, lie down; and if he calls you, say, 'Speak, Lord, for your servant listens."

As I've shared with y'all in the past from my own vocation story, I remember hearing the Lord calling me to the priesthood when I received my first Holy Communion at age seven, but at the time I didn't understand it. It wasn't until later, when I was in the tenth grade, that I heard the call again in Eucharistic Adoration and began to understand it. In some ways I can relate to Samuel's story, and I share this to illustrate how God continues to call men to follow Him as priests, if only we have a listening heart to hear and wise mentors to help us understand.

Priesthood Sunday is next weekend. I am so grateful to God for the gift of the priesthood and the grace to say yes to the call. Please pray for Fr. Francis and me and for all our priests. And please join me in praying for an abundance of new priestly vocations, and in encouraging those who might be called to follow where the Lord leads


