From The Desk of The Parochial Vicar

The wrath of Jesus



The gospel of today, the feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome, is about the cleansing of the temple by Jesus. On entering the Temple and seeing the business activities going on there, Jesus made a whip out of cords and disrupted the business activities by driving them out of the temple area. What moved Jesus to such wrath?

Jesus acted as he did because God's house was being desecrated. In that court of God's house in Jerusalem, there was worship without reverence amid arguments about prices and the clatter of the marketplace. Worship without reverence can be a terrible thing. It may be worship which is formalized and pushed through anyhow that the most dignified prayers can be read like a passage from an auctioneer's catalogue. It may be the use of the house of God in a way that reverence and true function of God's house are forgotten.

There is another reason Jesus acted as he did. Mark has a curious little addition which none of the other gospels has: "My house shall be called the house of prayer for all the nations (Mark 11:17). The Temple in Jerusalem consisted of a series of courts. There was the Court of the Gentiles, the Court of the Women, the Court of the Israelites and the Court of the Priests. All the buying and selling was going on in the Court of the Gentile which was the only place the Gentile were allowed to pray and worship God. The Temple authorities and Jewish leaders were turning the Court of the Gentiles into an uproar and a rabble where no man could pray. This conduct shut out the seeking Gentiles from the presence of God.

By showing his anger at such conducts perpetuated against the Gentiles, Jesus tells us that he will never hold guiltless those who make it impossible for others to worship him. It can happen that a spirit of bitterness, a spirit of argument, a spirit of strife can get into a Church which makes worship impossible. Men and office-bearers can be so concerned with their rights and their wrongs, their dignities and their prestige, their practice, and their procedure, that in the end no one can worship God in the atmosphere which is created. So, the gospel asks us to drop anything in our church life which keeps the seeking child of God out or make it difficult for him or her to commune with God.

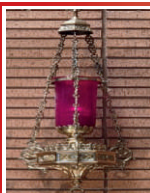

The sanctuary light burns in memory of Frank Martinez by the Martinez Family



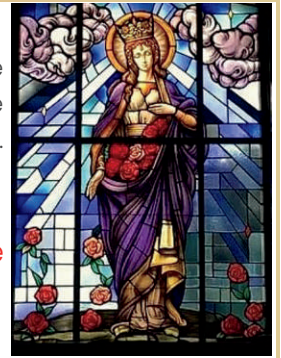
