From The Desk of The Pastor

Year-End Appeal



As the end of the year approaches, and as this weekend we celebrate our patronal feast, I write to you to ask that you please remember our parish in your year-end charitable giving. Many other institutions and causes solicit contributions this time of year, some with great urgency. Here's why I propose prioritizing the Church, and specifically our local church, when it comes to giving:

1. **We proclaim Christ and worship Him in the Church.** It is in our parish that we "sing praise to the LORD with [...] melodious song" as the Psalmist says. It is in our parish that Malachi's prophecy is fulfilled, that we who fear the LORD's name encounter Jesus Christ who is "the sun of justice with its healing rays". The Church draws us in as a community of disciples and nourishes us with the sacraments especially within the parish, which exists precisely for that purpose.

2. **We need your support.** It takes money to keep our parish running, in addition to the work of our wonderful volunteers. Beyond our regular operational and special programming expenses, we have the responsibility of renewing our parish facilities, not "with costly stones", but more often in unseen but necessary ways, like HVAC repairs and security improvements.

3. **Each of us has a responsibility to provide for the material needs of the Church.** This is one of the five precepts of the Church, and it flows from our common vocation to be collaborators with the Lord in His salvific mission. We aren't just spectators in the faith!

4. **We strive to be good stewards.** My team and I strive to imitate St. Paul in working hard, motivated by love of the Lord and our parishioners, "so as not to burden any of you" beyond what is needed. We know the value of a dollar, and we're grateful for every contribution, big or small, so we're careful not to waste anything of what we are given.

With much gratitude for those who already give sacrificially of their time, talent, and treasure – and especially their prayers! – to build up and sustain our parish, I ask that you please remember the needs of the Church now and throughout the year, and join me in the mission of glorifying God and saving souls.
