From The Desk of The Parochial Vicar

Our Kingdom is not of this World



The gospel reading of today ends with the prayerful request of one of the thieves crucified alongside Jesus. He said: "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom."

This last-minute profession of faith by the repentant thief and granting of his request by Jesus tell us that this world is not our destination. As we celebrate the solemnity of Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, the Church reminds us that we are not just citizens of this world; we are also citizens of heaven. There are some consequences of embracing the worldview that we are merely citizens of the world.

Firstly, such worldview turns us into ourselves and forces us to take the personality of the unrepentant thief who mocked Jesus and made demands that would benefit only him. Such worldview pushes us to negative self-preservation, hedonism, and absolutism. Thus, truth becomes only whatever enhances or favors the self. This is dangerous for society, especially when this self is understood merely as material.

Secondly, when we believe that our kingdom is of this world, we embrace the relativity of values and truth. It also abrogates objective truth, which transcends the fragilities of human existence. Morality is then based on convenience and pragmatism; just as the rulers and soldiers, in today's gospel, were reviling Jesus to descend from the cross as proof of the truth of his message. When we live under the sovereignty of the human will, the world suffers from domination and destruction of the weak and the poor by the high and mighty because there will be nothing like obedience to a higher order.

Finally, a world in which sovereignty is not from God leaves no space for grace. We are called to be people who depend on God's grace and who recognize that our successes and achievements are products of God's grace. This is why we are inspired to be humble. Take this away, and what stays are loneliness, frustration, and boredom with no breathing space and freshness. When the repentant thief met Jesus with openness and admittance of his wrongs, he experienced the grace of God which brought him peace while the unrepentant thief experienced frustration and pain.

Dear friends, we need God to achieve our best potentials. Let us always remember that cut off from him, we can do nothing (John 15:5). Let us open our hearts for him to reign in us and, through us, to save the world.
