

Uniting Our Hearts in Prayer

IN THE DESERT

Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert for forty days, and then the devil tested Him. Moses and the Israelites had been in the desert for forty years before being led to the land of milk and honey. There were times when they called out to God, sure that, as Saint Paul wrote to the Romans, "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." We sometimes spend time in the desert as well. Not a literal desert most of the time, but a desert in which it seems difficult to perceive God's presence, times when we face difficulty and are tempted to leave God's ways behind. On this First Sunday of Lent, Jesus shows us what to do in these moments: stand firm and trust in God.

Gospel Reflection—March 6, 2022 1st Sunday of Lent

One of the greatest temptations human beings face is leaving the truth of who they are, where they came from and who created them in pursuit of more personal satisfactions. When we consider all that desires our attention in a given day, there are many lures that attract us to illusions about ourselves. We can easily find ourselves distracted or tired, preoccupied with preserving our status in life, social relationships, current trends, and corporate demands, and intrigued by pursuing what we perceive to be the "path of least resistance." The daily concerns of life can quickly take our eyes off of our truth, making the empty promises of worldly accomplishments and ideologies seem so attractive. What is at risk in giving into this temptation?

We cease giving thanks to and worshipping our Creator as we pursue our own self-sufficiency, power, and prestige. We replace the true God with a "pet" one. While many do not totally dismiss the idea of God and pretend to remain at least remotely connected, they do not invest themselves heart, mind, and soul in the relationship either. That is why we are so easily swayed. If something attractive comes along, we lunge for it. After all, having a position above and over everyone else is a good thing, isn't it? In more honest moments, many have to admit that they believe this to be true. The Evil One is very convincing. But he can only gain control if we allow him to.

About temptation, St. Basil remarks, "As the pilot of a vessel is tried in the storm, as the wrestler is tried in the ring, the soldier in the battle and the hero in adversity, so is the Christian tried in temptation." And here is found the reason for Lent. It is a wonderful opportunity to get a handle on the attractive lures of illusion that easily captivate us and bring us off track. It is also a time for some honest reflection rooted in prayer, fasting, and selfless giving that can bring us to temptation's remedy: love. Love of His Father gave Jesus resistance. It can do the same for us.

Liturgical Minister Training for Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist will take place on Wednesday, March 9 and March 16, 2022 at Incarnation Church which is located at 5757 W. 127th Street in Crestwood. Both sessions must be attended and run from 7:00 PM – 9:00 PM. Once you have completed training, a short individualized training session will be held at St. Stephen to familiarize you with our procedures.







Rozważania O Miłosierdziu Bożym

Miłosierdzie poprzedzające sprawiedliwość

Bóg nie jest samą sprawiedliwością. Jest On przede wszystkim Miłosierdziem. Miłosierdzie to miłość, która pochyla się nad słabością, niedolą materialną i duchową, nad cierpieniem. Na ziemi bez przerwy doznajemy różnych przejawów bogactwa Bożego miłosierdzia. Ujawnia się ono między innymi w tym, że Bóg daje łaskę wystarczającą do zbawienia każdemu człowiekowi. Pragnie On, aby sąd był dla nas jak najłagodniejszy i zakończył się otrzymaniem jak największej nagrody. Bogaty w miłosierdzie Bóg niechętnie posługuje się karą, jest cierpliwy, przebacza nam grzechy, daje czas na nawrócenie, na duchowe dojrzewanie i na naprawianie wyrządzonego zła. Pozwala nam też wynagradzać tym, których dotknęło spowodowane przez nas zło. Wyrazem Bożego miłosierdzia jest też surowe prorockie ostrzeganie nas przed konsekwencjami naszych złych czynów a także bolesne działania, mające na celu ocalenie nas od wiecznego potępienia.

Bóg dał nam i ciągle daje nam dowody Swego wielkiego miłosierdzia. Pan Stworzenia nie jest samą tylko sprawiedliwością, która za każdy zły czyn od razu zsyła karę. Objawił się nam jako Bóg "bogaty w miłosierdzie" (Ef 2,4), jako "Ojciec miłosierdzia i Bóg wszelkiej pociechy" (2 Kor 1,3). Miłosierdzie Boże ujawniło się w tym, że postanowił uratować człowieka, który zasłużył na wieczną karę potępienia. To wypływające z Bożego miłosierdzia dzieło ratowania człowieka dokonało się i nadal realizuje się przez Jezusa Chrystusa i zesłanego nam Ducha Świętego.
