We warmly welcome new members to St. Stephen. To register, please stop by the Parish Office during regular business hours.

#### **Active Parishioner Status**

In order to be considered as a godparent for the Sacraments of Baptism and/or a sponsor for the Sacrament of Confirmation, a person must be verified as an "active member" of a Catholic parish. While assessments of the inquiry will be made individually, the following factors are considered when making the determination of whether or not a person is an active parishioner. Is the person:

- Properly registered and supporting the Church?
- Faithfully attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days?
- Participating in parish activities when possible?
- Using the parish envelope system or electronic giving system in support of our parish?

Adult children living at home are required to register separately from their parents as parishioners.






## Attention all Seniors Young at Heart

## Wniebowzięcie Najświętszej Maryi Panny

Wniebowzięcie (łac. assumptio) Najświętszej Maryi Panny oznacza udzielony Jej przez Boga nadprzyrodzony przywilej, na mocy którego, zakończywszy swoje ziemskie życie, została wzięta do nieba z ciałem i duszą. Najstarsza tradycja chrześcijańska używała także określenia "zaśnięcie" (łac. dormitio) i "przejście" (łac. transitus), podkreślając związek losu Maryi z Paschą ("przejściem") Jej Syna oraz postrzeganym jako "przejście" dniem narodzin dla nieba męczenników.

Przywilej wniebowzięcia jest nierozerwalnie związany z przywilejem niepokalanego poczęcia Maryi, czyli zachowaniem Jej od zmazy grzechu pierworodnego. Obydwa przywileje wskazują na wielką godność ludzkiego ciała, które współuczestniczy w obdarowywaniu człowieka łaską zarówno w doczesności, jak i w wieczności. Prawda o wniebowzięciu nie rozstrzyga, czy Maryja umarła, czy raczej przeszła na drugą stronę życia w inny sposób, znany jedynie Bogu. Tak czy inaczej, nieobecność jakiegokolwiek grzechu oraz trwałe dziewictwo i Boże macierzyństwo przesądziły o absolutnie wyjątkowym zakończeniu przez Nią ziemskiego życia. Jak grób, w którym złożono ciało Jezusa jest pusty, stanowiąc świadectwo Jego zmartwychwstania, tak nie ma również grobu Maryi z Jej ciałem ani nie ma Jej relikwii.



#### St. Maximilian Kolbe

Courage and sacrificial love mark the life of St. Maximilian Kolbe. He became a priest of the Franciscan order. Dedicated with evangelization, he published a magazine to teach the Catholic faith and encourage devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary. During the Nazi occupation of Poland, Fr. Kolbe was arrested and sent to Auschwitz. One day a prisoner escaped from the camp. The Nazi punishment was harsh. For one escapee, 10 must die in his place. The guards picked 10 men at random. One began to beg for his life on behalf of his family, and another man stepped forward and offered to take his place. Fr. Kolbe was sentenced, along with the other nine men, to death by starvation. For this "martyr of Auschwitz," a life of devotion culminated in one heroic, Christlike act.




