Dear St. Stephen Parishioners,

This Lent, we are participating in a survey conducted by the Catholic Leadership Institute. The *Disciple Maker Index (DMI) Survey* allows parishioners to reflect on their own spiritual growth and discipleship and identify the ways in which the parish can effectively support that growth. It will be available until March 31st. It also allows parishioners to share what they think is working well and how St. Stephen Parish could better help them grow closer to God, to one another as a faith community, and more. We are looking for answers to questions like: In what ways does our parish help you grow spiritually? How good are we at connecting you to others in the parish? In what ways do you feel invited to share your talents at our parish? These will be invaluable to me, the staff, and our many volunteers as we seek ways to best support everyone in their spiritual journey.

The web-based survey, consisting of 75 questions, is accessible online from our webpage and in paper form and should take about 15 minutes to complete. All surveys are confidential and the parish will only receive information about the community as a whole. We will NOT have access to individual survey responses. This survey offers us a unique and important opportunity to learn about issues of importance to parishioners in a confidential and professional way. We will use these results to 1) look at opportunities to support parishioner growth in discipleship and 2) create goals and plans to achieve that growth. Results will be available late spring or early summer and will be shared with the entire parish.

We really need the input of every parishioner to make this a success. If you have an opportunity, please stress the importance of responding to this survey to your family and friends. Meanwhile, if you have any questions or ideas about good ways to get more people to participate, please contact Barbara Black in our parish office.



The Invest in Kids Act Tax Credit Scholarship Program helps children from low- income homes receive scholarships that cover up to 100% of a Catholic school's tuition. Thanks to the generosity of our community, Cardinal Joseph Bernardin Elementary School has raised \$18,000 and of that \$18,000 is being matched for a grand total \$36,000.

We still need your help.

This year, more than 4,400 children are waiting for the opportunity to attend a school in the archdiocese with the help of the Illinois Invest in Kids Tax Credit Scholarship Program, including 8 on the waitlist at Cardinal Joseph Bernardin Elementary School.

ARE YOU LOOKING FOR WAYS TO HELP THE CHURCH?


Volunteers Needed



We warmly welcome new members to St. Stephen. To register, please stop by the Parish Office during regular business hours.

Active Parishioner Status

In order to be considered as a godparent for the Sacraments of Baptism and/or a sponsor for the Sacrament of Confirmation, a person must be verified as an "active member" of a Catholic parish. While assessments of the inquiry will be made individually, the following factors are considered when making the determination of whether or not a person is an active parishioner. Is the person:

- Properly registered and supporting the Church?
- Faithfully attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days?
- Participating in parish activities when possible?
- Using the parish envelope system or electronic giving system in support of our parish?

Adult children living at home are required to register separately from their parents as parishioners.

Sacrament of Baptism

New parishioners are required to register and a baptism preparation class is required. Start the inquiry process at www.ststephentinley.com/baptism-prep

- English baptisms are celebrated at 2:30pm on the first and third Sunday of every month.
- Polish baptisms are celebrated at 2:00pm on the second Sunday of the month and during the 12:30pm Polish Mass on the fourth Sunday of the month.
