We warmly welcome new members to St. Stephen. To register, please stop by the Parish Office during regular business hours.

Active Parishioner Status

In order to be considered as a godparent for the Sacraments of Baptism and/or a sponsor for the Sacrament of Confirmation, a person must be verified as an "active member" of a Catholic parish. While assessments of the inquiry will be made individually, the following factors are considered when making the determination of whether or not a person is an active parishioner. Is the person:

- Properly registered and supporting the Church?
- Faithfully attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days?
- Participating in parish activities when possible?
- Using the parish envelope system or electronic giving system in support of our parish?

Adult children living at home are required to register separately from their parents as parishioners.

New parishioners are required to register and a baptism preparation class is required. Start the inquiry process at www.ststephentinley.com/baptism-prep

- English baptisms are celebrated at 2:30pm on the first and third Sunday of every month.
- Polish baptisms are celebrated at 2:00pm on the second Sunday of the month and during the 12:30pm Polish Mass on the fourth Sunday of the month.

No Greater Love Brings Participants Closer to Jesus!

St. Stephen recently completed the 5 session bible study called, "No Greater Love - A Biblical Walk through Christ's Passion." It was perfect timing to lead into Lent, the holiest time of the year, leading to a deep appreciation for the incredible love Jesus has for each of us.

There were 113 participants in 10 small faith groups. Five groups were in hosted homes and five groups were hosted in the church. This study was so successful, we hope to double participants in the fall with a new Bible study which will require more facilitators.

Evaluations of the study rated it "excellent" 99% of the time. Participants consistently said they felt closer to Jesus and stronger in their faith. The small group format was a big hit allowing each person the opportunity to get involved in the discussions. It was interesting to see comments that wished the study was longer.

Below are just a couple of comments by participants:

When asked if the study affected their faith or connections to the church?

- This has helped me in understanding the church and it has deepened my faith.
- It has given me a deeper understanding of the Passion and made me want to be more connected to the church.
- It enriched my knowledge of the Passion and the significance of so many details in the Old Testament. The sacrifice of Jesus for us all is profound!


Everything I learned brings me closer to Our Lord and strengthens my faith and understanding.

- I feel closer to Jesus.





Gospel Meditation Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

A young, engaged couple sat on the couch in front of me as we chatted about their upcoming marriage. The young lady was struggling to trust her future husband. She told me her father had been unfaithful to her mother. She said of her fiancé, "I want him to prove to me that he won't cheat on me." The young man looked at me helplessly, raised his eyebrows and shrugged his shoulders. What evidence could he possibly give to validate such a proof? Nothing. All he could do was invite her to trust him.

We all are wounded by experiences of imperfect love. We also are tempted to demand from God proof of His fidelity and goodness. We are like St. Thomas the Apostle who, on that second Sunday of Easter, demands proof of the Lord's resurrection. "Unless I see the mark of the nail ... I will not believe." Our science, technology and mathematics can indeed prove a great deal. But there are some things that require trusting another person. We prove promises of love only by trusting.

St. Thomas indeed saw the wounds of Jesus and believed. But there is an even greater blessing for us who simply trust Him — and all the truths the Church proclaims — because of the trustworthiness of the Risen One who speaks. This week let's trust Jesus without seeing him.

Rozważania do Niedzielnej Liturgii

O co proszę? O silną wiarę, uwolnienie od lęku i głęboki pokój serca

Będę wpatrywał się w uczniów, którzy po śmierci Jezusa znów są razem. Są pełni lęku i niepewności (w. 19). Wyobrażę sobie ich niespokojne twarze i oczy pełne strachu. Bez Jezusa czują się bezradni.



Czy nie odkrywam w sobie cech zachowania apostołów? Czy w cierpieniu nie zamykam się przed samym sobą i innymi? Wypowiem przed Jezusem lęki i obawy, które kuszą mnie do ucieczki od życia i jego wyzwań.

Zauważę, jak bardzo zmienia się atmosfera, gdy pośród apostołów zjawia się Jezus. Jego obecność zamienia ich lęk w radość (ww. 19-21). Będę prosił Jezusa o głębokie doświadczenie Jego obecności, zwłaszcza pośród moich niepewności i lęków.

Jezus dwukrotnie mówi do apostołów: "Pokój wam" (ww. 19.21). Będę chciał usłyszeć i głęboko przeżyć te słowa. Będę prosił o głębokie przekonanie, że Jezus codziennie pozdrawia mnie tymi słowami i zaprasza, abym otwierał się na przyjęcie Jego pokoju.

Tomasz, który nie był razem z uczniami, czuje się zagubiony (ww. 24-25). Słowa apostołów nie są w stanie Go zmienić. Potrzebuje doświadczenia osobistego spotkania z Jezusem. Czy szukam osobistych spotkań z Jezusem?

Będę kontemplował spotkanie Tomasza z Jezusem (ww. 26-29). Zobaczę, jak zmienia się jego twarz, jak pojawia się na niej zdziwienie i radość. Jezus zachęca Tomasza, aby Go dotknął. Czy w mojej modlitwie osobistej, w Eucharystii, w spowiedzi szukam i pragnę intymnego spotkania z Jezusem?

Zaproszę do mojej modlitwy św. Tomasza i razem z nim będę prosił o silną wiarę i pokój serca. Zachowam w sercu modlitwę Tomasza: "Pan mój i Bóg mój!".




Divine Mercy Novena & Holy Hour Sunday, April 16th
