We warmly welcome new members to St. Stephen. To register, please stop by the Parish Office during regular business hours.

Active Parishioner Status

In order to be considered as a godparent for the Sacraments of Baptism and/or a sponsor for the Sacrament of Confirmation, a person must be verified as an "active member" of a Catholic parish. While assessments of the inquiry will be made individually, the following factors are considered when making the determination of whether or not a person is an active parishioner. Is the person:

- Properly registered and supporting the Church?
- Faithfully attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days?
- Participating in parish activities when possible?
- Using the parish envelope system or electronic giving system in support of our parish?

Adult children living at home are required to register separately from their parents as parishioners.



Gospel Meditation Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

I recently rescued a dog. She's a terrier and rather adorable. And she's crazy about me. She could spend all day with me. But I'm a pastor at a parish and sometimes I leave her at the front desk of the church office. She constantly amazes me by her ability to distinguish between my voice and that of everyone else. If I say one word, even if I'm hidden around a corner, she'll sprint toward me and jump up into my arms.

This week the readings focus our attention to the voice of the risen Jesus Christ. Comparing his disciples to sheep and himself to a shepherd, he says, "They recognize his voice." He speaks to us and wants us to respond. When we hear his voice, we follow. Throughout this coming week, we will experience many interior promptings to receive God's love, and to love Him in return. That's his voice. Follow it into the safe and tender arms of Christ.

By contrast, some voices we will hear do not convey God's concern and love for us, but rather produce fear, despair, and other harmful mischief. Jesus calls these voices those of robbers. Does an idea or thought make it harder for you to love God? If so, run away. Let it go. It is most likely not the voice of the Risen Lord. Keep waiting for him to speak. You will recognize his voice. Then run to him as fast as you can.

Right in time to celebrate Earth Week, St. Elizabeth Seton Parish invites all to its first-ever Creation Care Art Gallery Exhibit. In offering this art exhibit, Fr. Bill Corcoran, pastor, recognized the educational opportunity this art contest could provide to explain what is meant by Care for Creation—its relationship to environmental sustainability and to reinforce the connection to the Catholic faith. The gallery exhibit includes a total of 45 creative artworks that were submitted by adults as well as students from local public high schools, Providence Catholic High School, Cardinal Joseph Bernardin School, and St. Elizabeth Seton Religious Ed Program (with permission). This juried art contest offered cash prizes to First and Second Place winners from two categories (Digital and Traditional Art) and three age levels (Youth, Teen, and Adult).


Pope Francis in his encyclical *Laudato Si'*: On Care for Our Common Home, discussed the importance for all people to recognize that all living things on Earth, human and non-human, and the resources that support life, are inextricably interconnected. And that when we act in a way that harms nature, we are really harming ourselves. Francis made the point that it is a social justice issue because those who will suffer the most from the ecological degradation that is occurring are the poor and future generations, who are least responsible for causing the problems. It becomes clear when reading the encyclical that we have a moral obligation to be less wasteful, more mindful of the impact of our lifestyles, and towards living in a way that allows future generations the ability to flourish. This, in part, is what is meant by Care for Creation. It is one of seven themes of Catholic Social Teaching, and a way for us to show our respect to the Creator for this great gift that has been given to us.

The free gallery of Creation Care artwork will be on display in the St. Elizabeth Seton Church Narthex, 9300 W. 167th St., Orland Hills, on April 29, from 4:30-6:00 pm, and Sunday, April 30, from 7:30 am-12:30 pm.


