We warmly welcome new members to St. Stephen. To register, please stop by the Parish Office during regular business hours.

Active Parishioner Status

In order to be considered as a godparent for the Sacraments of Baptism and/or a sponsor for the Sacrament of Confirmation, a person must be verified as an "active member" of a Catholic parish. While assessments of the inquiry will be made individually, the following factors are considered when making the determination of whether or not a person is an active parishioner. Is the person:

- Properly registered and supporting the Church?
- Faithfully attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days?
- Participating in parish activities when possible?
- Using the parish envelope system or electronic giving system in support of our parish?

Adult children living at home are required to register separately from their parents as parishioners.

New parishioners are required to register and a baptism preparation class is required. Start the inquiry process at www.ststephentinley.com/baptism-prep

- English baptisms are celebrated at 2:30pm on the first and third Sunday of every month.
- Polish baptisms are celebrated at 2:00pm on the second Sunday of the month and during the 12:30pm Polish Mass on the fourth Sunday of the month.





O co proszę? O doświadczenie zażyłej relacji z Bogiem Ojcem

Jezus żegna się z apostołami. Zwrócę uwagę, z jaką czułością i troską zwraca się do nich. Zna do głębi ich serca. Jest wrażliwy na ich przeżycia: "Niech się nie trwoży serce wasze" (w. 1).

Z uwagą będę słuchał słów Jezusa. Pomyślę, że mówi wprost do mnie. Zna obecny stan mojego serca. Jakie uczucia odnajduję w tej chwili w moim wnętrzu? Czego w życiu boję się najbardziej? Spróbuję zawierzyć Jezusowi to wszystko, co odbiera mi poczucie bezpieczeństwa i wywołuje lęki.

Jezus opowiada mi o wieczności. Mówi mi, że jest dom, w którym oczekuje mnie Ojciec. Jakie myśli i uczucia budzą się we mnie, gdy spontanicznie zaczynam rozważać o wieczności? Czy potrafi ę wyobrazić sobie Boga jako Ojca, który oczekuje mnie z tęsknotą?

Jezus, który zna serca apostołów, uświadamia im prawdę, że nie znają Ojca, nie mają o Nim prawdziwego wyobrażenia (ww. 7-10). Jaki jest mój obraz Ojca? Czy wywołuje on we mnie uczucia ciepła, miłości, bezpieczeństwa? Czy mój obraz Ojca nie wywołuje we mnie negatywnych uczuć. Czy potrafi ę wyobrazić sobie siebie jako dziecko tulone w ramionach Ojca?

Jezus mówi, że pomoże mi odnaleźć prawdziwy obraz Ojca. On, który sam jeden wie, jak cudowne i pełne dobroci jest oblicze Ojca. Chce, abym i ja Go poznał. Chce być moją drogą do Ojca. Będę więc prosił jak Filip, z pokorą i szczerością: "Panie, pokaż mi Ojca" (w. 9).

Poproszę Jezusa, aby moje uczucia przeniknął swoimi uczuciami do Ojca, abym mógł pragnąć Ojca Jego pragnieniami, aby nauczył mnie zbliżać się do Ojca jak dziecko. Będę powtarzał: "Ojcze nasz…".





Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

If you had to summarize the essential core of the Christian life, what would it be? Mercy, truth, or love, perhaps? The readings today suggest another word which may surprise you. That word is *priesthood*.

St. Peter says to us, "You are a 'chosen race, a royal priesthood..." To be part of a priesthood is to offer a particular sacrifice in order for the community to survive and thrive. Jesus is the great high priest because he offers the one perfect sacrifice which heals and perfects the entire human race. Peter the Apostle wants us to know that all the baptized share in this priestly ministry. The whole of our lives, including every detail, is meant to become our acceptable offering to God.

The baptized exercise this priesthood in many ways, I'll mention three. At Sunday Mass, in private prayer, and in daily work. At Mass, we offer the sacrifice of our lives with that of the priest, who symbolizes Christ the Priest.
