## **Parishioner Registration**

We warmly welcome new members to St. Stephen. To register, please stop by the Parish Office during regular business hours.

#### **Active Parishioner Status**

In order to be considered as a godparent for the Sacraments of Baptism and/or a sponsor for the Sacrament of Confirmation, a person must be verified as an "active member" of a Catholic parish. While assessments of the inquiry will be made individually, the following factors are considered when making the determination of whether or not a person is an active parishioner. Is the person:

- Properly registered and supporting the Church?
- Faithfully attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days?
- Participating in parish activities when possible?
- Using the parish envelope system or electronic giving system in support of our parish?

Adult children living at home are required to register separately from their parents as parishioners.

## Sacrament of Baptism

New parishioners are required to register and a baptism preparation class is required. Start the inquiry process at www.ststephentinley.com/baptism-prep

- English baptisms are celebrated at 2:30pm on the first and third Sunday of every month.
- Polish baptisms are celebrated at 2:00pm on the second Sunday of the month and during the 12:30pm Polish Mass on the fourth Sunday of the month.

# Gospel Meditation Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

My dad was adopted as a baby. It's a big part of my family's story. His birth mother placed him in a Catholic orphanage not long after birth. A young couple longing for a baby strolled among the bassinets. My father, then only a few months old, looked at the husband and smiled. The man said, "That's my son." They took him home and the family grew. This moment of adoption was a wonderful truth they celebrated even when my dad was a young boy. They told him, "You're even more special than the other children, because we chose you to be our son." My dad's eyes well up with tears of gratitude whenever he tells the story, even eighty-three years later.

What is your story? Do we think or act like unwanted orphans? Who do we believe ourselves to be? As we continue to ponder Jesus' resurrection, we hear him say to us this Sunday, "I will not leave you orphans." God doesn't leave us alone like spiritual orphans. The power that raised Jesus from the dead is the Holy Spirit, who is also called the Spirit of Adoption. He chooses us to be His children, to share God's life forever. He gives us a future filled with hope. We are not orphans anymore! This Easter, that's the story we should share with others. It's the true story we are living right now.



## O co proszę? O głębokie doświadczenie czułej opieki Jezusa

Jezus żegna się z uczniami. Chcę być razem z apostołami i wsłuchiwać się w Jego słowa, które tchną niezwykłą miłością. Jezus zaprasza mnie do nawiązania z Nim głębokiej przyjaźni. Najbardziej wiarygodną odpowiedzią, jaką mogę Mu dać, jest kroczenie drogą Jego przykazań (w. 15.21).

Jezus zapewnia mnie, że modli się za mnie do Ojca. Spróbuję dłużej zatrzymać się nad słowami: "Ja zaś będę prosił Ojca..." (w. 16-17). Uświadomię sobie, że Jezus rozmawia z Ojcem o moim życiu.

Wyobrażę sobie, jak Ojciec słucha prośby Jezusa, który wstawia się za mną, jak z czułością wysłuchuje Jezusa, spełnia Jego prośby i posyła mi Ducha Prawdy i Pocieszyciela. Uświadomię sobie, że każda chwila mojego życia jest darem Boga. Uwielbię Go za czułą miłość.

Wsłucham się w tkliwe i czułe słowa Jezusa, który mówi do apostołów i do mnie: "Nie zostawię was sierotami. Przyjdę do was" (w. 18). Przypomnę sobie moje doświadczenia samotności i bezradności, gdy czułem się w życiu jak porzucone, niechciane dziecko. Uświadomię sobie, że Jezus nigdy mnie nie opuszcza. Poproszę Go o głębokie przeżycie tej prawdy.

Jezus odsłania mi tajemnicę swojej bliskości. Przypomina mi, że w pełni poznam ją dopiero w wieczności (w. 20). Obecnie jest mi potrzebna wiara, że On jest we mnie, a ja w Nim. Uraduję się tą prawdą. Jezus zawsze nosi mnie w swoim sercu. Zapytam, czy moje serce jest otwarte na Jezusa.

W serdecznej rozmowie będę zwierzał się z przeżyć serca, które rodzi we mnie usłyszana obietnica Jezusa. Wyznam Mu: "Jesteś największą obietnicą mojego życia!".
