We warmly welcome new members to St. Stephen. To register, please stop by the Parish Office during regular business hours.

Active Parishioner Status

In order to be considered as a godparent for the Sacraments of Baptism and/or a sponsor for the Sacrament of Confirmation, a person must be verified as an "active member" of a Catholic parish. While assessments of the inquiry will be made individually, the following factors are considered when making the determination of whether or not a person is an active parishioner. Is the person:

- Properly registered and supporting the Church?
- Faithfully attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days?
- Participating in parish activities when possible?
- Using the parish envelope system or electronic giving system in support of our parish?

Adult children living at home are required to register separately from their parents as parishioners.

New parishioners are required to register and a baptism preparation class is required. Start the inquiry process at www.ststephentinley.com/baptism-prep

- English baptisms are celebrated at 2:30pm on the first and third Sunday of every month.
- Polish baptisms are celebrated at 2:00pm on the second Sunday of the month and during the 12:30pm Polish Mass on the fourth Sunday of the month.

Słowa Ewangelii według Świętego Mateusza (Mt 28, 16-20)

Jedenastu uczniów udało się do Galilei, na górę, tam gdzie Jezus im polecił.

A gdy Go ujrzeli, oddali Mu pokłon. Niektórzy jednak wgtpili.

Wtedy Jezus podszedł do nich i przemówił tymi słowami:

«Dana Mi jest wszelka władza w niebie i na ziemi.

Idźcie więc i nauczajcie wszystkie narody, udzielając im chrztu w imię Ojca i Syna, i Ducha Świętego.

Uczcie je zachowywać wszystko, co wam przykazałem.

A oto Ja jestem z wami przez wszystkie dni, aż do skończenia świata».

O co proszę? O radość i głęboką wiarę w nieustanną obecność Jezusa w moim życiu

"Przyłączę się" do Jedenastu. Są w drodze do Galilei, jak polecił im Jezus (w. 16). Wracają do miejsca, gdzie Go poznali, gdzie razem mieszkali, gdzie przeżywali swoją codzienność. Pomyślę o mojej Galilei, o mojej codzienności. To Jezus mi ją ofi arował...

Uczniowie ujrzeli Jezusa w Galilei (w. 17). Jezus pozwala mi doświadczać Jego obecności pośród codzienności: w rodzinie, wspólnocie, w ludziach, których spotykam, w zwykłych zajęciach. Czy Go zauważam? Czy "oddaję Mu pokłon"?

"Niektórzy jednak wątpili" (w. 17). Przypatrzę się twarzom uczniów, którzy nie potrafi ą rozpoznać Jezusa, wątpią, czy to naprawdę On i czy pozostanie z Nimi na zawsze. Czy jestem pewny obecności Jezusa, czy wierzę, że mnie nie opuszcza?

Wyobrażę sobie, że Jezus zbliża się do mnie i patrząc mi w oczy, mówi: "Dana mi jest wszelka władza" (w. 18). Czy wierzę, że Jezus ma władzę nad wszystkim, co dzieje się w moim życiu? O co chciałbym Go prosić?

Wsłucham się w słowa Jezusa, który rozsyła uczniów (w. 19). Wyobrażę sobie siebie pośród nich. Jezus mówi i do mnie: "Idź na cały świat". Pomyślę o świecie, w którym codziennie się obracam. Czy potrafię być świadkiem Jezusa?

Jezus chce, abym zachowywał wszystko, co od Niego usłyszałem. Co mogę powiedzieć o mojej wierności przykazaniom, Ewangelii? Poświęce więcej czasu na rozeznanie mojej wierności Jezusowi.

Jezus zostawia mi obietnicę, która może stać się dla mnie oparciem w najtrudniejszych momentach życia (w. 20). Będę powtarzał moje wyznanie wiary: "Wierzę, że jesteś ze mną przez wszystkie dni!".
