We warmly welcome new members to St. Stephen. To register, please stop by the Parish Office during regular business hours.

Active Parishioner Status

In order to be considered as a godparent for the Sacraments of Baptism and/or a sponsor for the Sacrament of Confirmation, a person must be verified as an "active member" of a Catholic parish. While assessments of the inquiry will be made individually, the following factors are considered when making the determination of whether or not a person is an active parishioner. Is the person:

- Properly registered and supporting the Church?
- Faithfully attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days?
- Participating in parish activities when possible?
- Using the parish envelope system or electronic giving system in support of our parish?

Adult children living at home are required to register separately from their parents as parishioners.

New parishioners are required to register and a baptism preparation class is required. Start the inquiry process at www.ststephentinley.com/baptism-prep

- English baptisms are celebrated at 2:30pm on the first and third Sunday of every month.
- Polish baptisms are celebrated at 2:00pm on the second Sunday of the month and during the 12:30pm Polish Mass on the fourth Sunday of the month.

Corpus Christi

The solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ

How did the feast of Corpus Christi originate?

The solemnity and procession of Corpus Christi dates back to the 13th century. St. Juliana (1193-1258) was a nun and mystic who had a series of visions in which she was instructed by Our Lord to work to establish a feast for the Holy Eucharist. After many years of trying, she finally convinced the bishop, the future Pope Urban IV, to create this special feast in honor of the Blessed Sacrament. Eucharistic processions began shortly after the institution of the solemnity of Corpus Christi.

What is a eucharistic procession?

A Eucharistic procession is a public witness honoring the most Holy Eucharist, carried through the streets.

The Corpus Christi procession is a beautiful public witness of faith, hope, and unity.

Why is a Eucharistic procession on Corpus Christi important?

There are many graces to be found in walking our streets in solemn procession with Jesus. With everything that is happening in our world right now, we want to show our belief in the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. We hope to restore, renew, and revive our own beliefs as well as to bless our whole community and the world. We will pray and sing as our priests bless the four corners of the earth with the Lord at four different altars placing the planet under the protection of Christ.


Why are there four altars?

"The number four symbolizes the four corners of the earth that is, the whole universe, the world in which we live. The blessing is imparted in four directions with the intention of puting them under the protection of the Eucharistic Lord." — Joseph Cardinal Ratzinger

Why do we read from the four gospels?

The four Gospels are also proclaimed to cleanse the four winds of the earth as when Jesus said to St. Faustina during the Corpus Christi procession, "These rays of mercy will pass through you, just as they have passed through this Host, and they will go out through all the world [441]."





Gospel Meditation Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

In my experience, one of the peculiarities of being a man is the somewhat unlikely ability to look into the mirror, no matter how out of shape he may be, and declare with full confidence: "Looking good, buddy!" Ask a man. He'll probably confirm it.

Therein lies a mystery. You might think I refer to man's ability to deceive himself or his propensity toward vainglory. But in this case, I refer to the mystery of a healthy and proper sense of self-love. We human beings (both men and women) have the utterly weird ability to look at ourselves as if we were another. Then we tend to love this "other." Then, somehow, that love becomes a bond between the two. We are three and yet one.

This Sunday is Trinity Sunday. We ponder anew that God in His unity is a play of multiplicity: Lover, Beloved, and shared Love. Or, as we also proclaim, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. If we allow it, this mystery heals our temptation toward self-hatred and destruction. We all know how awful it is to look into the mirror and not know the person we see, or, equally bad, to know and hate who we see. Jesus, the Son of God, draws us into the dynamics of authentic self-knowledge and self-love. Perhaps we could ask the Holy Trinity this Sunday to teach us to truly look at ourselves and to properly love who we see looking back.







MUSIC CORNER

It has been a short six months since I have served as the music director for our parish as well as coordinating the music ministry here in the past two years. Throughout that time, I'm sure you've noticed gradual changes across our liturgies throughout the liturgical year. Please bear in mind that every music director at every parish has their own vision of how music plays a role in the liturgy.



Today, I write you to iterate that we will have a "mini-rehearsal" before each Mass to practice particular hymns. You'll notice in the title indexes in the Gather and Breaking Bread books that there are several hymns at our disposal, and we use many of them throughout the year. 

Parish Registry and Communications—When you register as a parishioner of St. Stephen Deacon and Martyr, you can elect to receive offertory envelopes in the mail. Important parish communication is sent out via mail and email, in addition to your weekly envelopes. Please help us to keep our records up to date. If you are moving out of the parish or out of state and will become inactive, please contact the parish office. Also, please let the parish office know if your mailing address, email address, or phone number has changed. This simple act reduces returned mail and saves the parish money on mailings.
