We warmly welcome new members to St. Stephen. To register, please stop by the Parish Office during regular business hours.

Active Parishioner Status

In order to be considered as a godparent for the Sacraments of Baptism and/or a sponsor for the Sacrament of Confirmation, a person must be verified as an "active member" of a Catholic parish. While assessments of the inquiry will be made individually, the following factors are considered when making the determination of whether or not a person is an active parishioner. Is the person:

- Properly registered and supporting the Church?
- Faithfully attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days?
- Participating in parish activities when possible?
- Using the parish envelope system or electronic giving system in support of our parish?

Adult children living at home are required to register separately from their parents as parishioners.

- English baptisms are celebrated at 2:30pm on the first and third Sunday of every month.







Rozważanie do liturgii

O co proszę? O dar kontemplacji oblicza Jezusa

Słowa Ewangelii według Świętego Mateusza (Mt 17, 1-9)

Jezus wziął z sobą Piotra, Jakuba oraz brata jego, Jana, i zaprowadził ich na górę wysoką, osobno. Tam przemienił się wobec nich: twarz Jego zajaśniała jak słońce, odzienie zaś stało się białe jak światło. A oto ukazali się im Mojżesz i Eliasz, rozmawiający z Nim.

Wtedy Piotr rzekł do Jezusa: «Panie, dobrze, że tu jesteśmy; jeśli chcesz, postawię tu trzy namioty: jeden dla Ciebie, jeden dla Mojżesza i jeden dla Eliasza».



Gdy on jeszcze mówił, oto obłok świetlany osłonił ich, a z obłoku odezwał się głos: «To jest mój Syn umiłowany, w którym mam upodobanie, Jego słuchajcie!» Uczniowie, słysząc to, upadli na twarz i bardzo się zlękli. A Jezus zbliżył się do nich, dotknął ich i rzekł: «Wstańcie, nie lękajcie się!» Gdy podnieśli oczy, nikogo nie widzieli, tylko samego Jezusa. A gdy schodzili z góry, Jezus przykazał im, mówiąc: «Nie opowiadajcie nikomu o tym widzeniu, aż Syn Człowieczy zmartwychwstanie».

Będę wpatrywał się w Jezusa, który prowadzi wybranych uczniów "na górę wysoką, osobno" Wie, że potrzebują duchowego umocnienia. Są przygnębieni Jego słowami o odrzuceniu, męce i krzyżu. Co mogę powiedzieć o moim obecnym stanie ducha? Co mnie wewnętrznie cieszy, a co gnębi? Poproszę Jezusa, aby poprowadził mnie "na górę wysoką, osobno", aby pomógł mi odnaleźć przestrzeń pustyni i żarliwej modlitwy osobistej.

Stanę blisko Jezusa i uczniów, na górze, w samotności, w głębokiej ciszy. Wyobrażę sobie Jezusa, który przemieniony, cały piękny, jaśnieje blaskiem jak słońce. Będę trwał z uczniami w kontemplacji oblicza Jezusa. Zbliżę się do Piotra i wsłucham się w jego słowa zachwytu. Razem z nim poproszę o głębokie doświadczenie obecności Jezusa i łaskę nasycania się Jego pięknem.

Będę trwał w prostych słowach uwielbienia: "Jezu, jesteś piękny! Dobrze mi, kiedy trwam przy Tobie". Wsłucham się w głos z nieba. Jakie przeżycia budzi we mnie? Co we mnie przeważa: doświadczenie pokoju czy lęk i niepokój? Czy mam głębokie upodobanie w Jezusie? Czy jest moim umiłowanym Bratem? Czy słucham Jego słowa?

Jezus podchodzi do mnie, podobnie jak do uczniów na górze, i mówi mi: "Wstań, nie lękaj się". Uchwycę się mocno Jego dłoni i będę Go prosił, aby pomógł mi podnieść się z moich lęków i duchowej niemocy. "Nikogo nie widzieli, tylko samego Jezusa" (w. 7). Będę wpatrywał się w Jezusa, powtarzając: "Zachowaj Twoje oblicze w moim sercu".



St. Lawrence

On August 10 we celebrate the feast of St. Lawrence. Can you tell us a bit about him?

Little is known about Lawrence other than he was a deacon during the reign of Emperor Valerian from 253–259. In 258, Valerian began a persecution of the Roman Church. Lawrence was in charge of the purse for the Church of Rome. Roman officials demanded that the riches of the church be handed over to them. Lawrence asked for a few days to gather them.

Lawrence took the money he had charge over and distributed it to the poor of Rome. Then he gathered all the homeless and poor together. When the officials came again demanding the riches of the church, Lawrence pointed to the destitute and homeless, saying that these were the true riches of the church. For this he was imprisoned and tortured, and put to death by burning on a gridiron. It is said that as he was dying, he told his executioners to turn him over because he was done on one side and needed to be fully cooked for the Lord.

Lawrence continues to be a model for us today. The church needs continual reminders that its riches are the people. The primary purpose and mission of the church is to be continually sensitive to the needs of all God's people, most especially the least of our brothers and sisters.


