Active Parishioner Status

In order to be considered as a godparent for the Sacraments of Baptism and/or a sponsor for the Sacrament of Confirmation, a person must be verified as an "active member" of a Catholic parish. While assessments of the inquiry will be made individually, the following factors are considered when making the determination of whether or not a person is an active parishioner. Is the person:

- Properly registered and supporting the Church?
- Faithfully attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days?
- Participating in parish activities when possible?
- Using the parish envelope system or electronic giving system in support of our parish?

Adult children living at home are required to register separately from their parents as parishioners.

- English baptisms are celebrated at 2:30pm on the first and third Sunday of every month.







O co proszę?

O nieustanne pragnienie "więcej" dla Jezusa

EWANGELIA (J 1, 6-8. 19-28) ŚWIADECTWO JANA CHRZCICIELA O CHRYSTUSIE

SŁOWA EWANGELII WEDŁUG ŚWIĘTEGO JANA

Pojawił się człowiek posłany przez Boga – Jan mu było na imię. Przyszedł on na świadectwo, aby zaświadczyć o światłości, by wszyscy uwierzyli przez niego. Nie był on światłością, lecz został posłany, aby zaświadczyć o światłości. Takie jest świadectwo Jana. Gdy Żydzi wysłali do niego z Jerozolimy kapłanów i lewitów z zapytaniem: «Kto ty jesteś? », on wyznał, a nie zaprzeczył, oświadczając: «Ja nie jestem Mesjaszem». Zapytali go: «Cóż zatem? Czy jesteś Eliaszem?» Odrzekł: «Nie jestem». «Czy ty jesteś prorokiem?» Odparł: «Nie». Powiedzieli mu więc: «Kim jesteś, abyśmy mogli dać odpowiedź tym, którzy nas wysłali? Co mówisz sam o sobie?»

Powiedział: «Jam głos wołającego na pustyni: Prostujcie drogę Pańską, jak rzekł prorok Izajasz». A wysłannicy byli spośród faryzeuszów. i zaczęli go pytać, mówiąc do niego: «Czemu zatem chrzcisz, skoro nie jesteś ani Mesjaszem, ani Eliaszem, ani prorokiem?» Jan im tak odpowiedział: «Ja chrzczę wodą. Pośród was stoi Ten, którego wy nie znacie, który po mnie idzie, a któremu ja nie jestem godzien odwiązać rzemyka u Jego sandała».

Działo się to w Betanii, po drugiej stronie Jordanu, gdzie Jan udzielał chrztu.

Wyobrażę sobie postać Jana Chrzciciela, który jest człowiekiem prostym i ubogim. Wpatrując się w niego, uświadomię sobie, że Bóg może posługiwać się w moim życiu skromnymi i słabymi osobami, aby wzbudzić we mnie silne pragnienie Jezusa (ww. 6-8).

Kto okazał się dla mnie posłanym od Boga Janem Chrzcicielem? Przywołam w sercu osoby, które stały się bardzo drogie w moim życiu duchowym i wlały we mnie wiele Bożego światła. Wspomnę je teraz przed Bogiem ze wzruszeniem i głęboką wdzięcznością.

"Co mówisz sam o sobie?" (w. 22). Zwrócę uwagę na stanowczość i pokorę, z jaką Jan Chrzciciel świadczy o swojej wierze. Słowa Jana odsłaniają moc jego ducha i pewność otrzymanego powołania (ww. 23-27).

Szczerze zapytam siebie wobec Boga: "Co mówię sam o sobie"? Jaki jest obraz mojego powołania? Czy dobrze rozeznałem moją drogę życia? Czy w życiu czuję się na swoim miejscu i czy wierzę, że jest to miejsce dane mi od Boga?

Wsłucham się uważnie w rozmowę Jana z wysłannikami. Zauważę, z jaką jasnością i pewnością mówi o nadchodzącym Zbawicielu (ww. 20-22). Nie skupia uwagi na sobie. Wie, że jest jedynie "głosem", którym Bóg posługuje się dla wypełnienia własnych zamiarów.

Czy w moich pragnieniach, słowach i rozmowach nie szukam siebie? Czy nie "używam" Boga do szukania swojej chwały?

W serdecznej rozmowie z Jezusem będę Go prosił, abym nie bał się świadczyć o Nim, także wtedy, gdy będę jak "głos wołającego na pustyni". Będę powtarzał w sercu modlitwę: "Pragnę, Jezu, budować tylko na Twoich słowach!".



Gospel Meditation Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

Why do we believe in Jesus and the Catholic Church? Why should we continue to do so? We've never seen him face-to-face (at least not most of us, I assume). Most of us have never had mystical visions of angels or saints. We live in the same world as our atheist and secularists friends. Why do we believe in Christ if we've never seen him?

The simple, symbolic answer the Gospel presents to us this week might surprise us: we believe because of John the Baptist. Early in John's Gospel we hear: "There was a man sent from God, his name was John. He came for testimony, to bear witness to the light, that all might believe through him." The Baptist powerfully announces Jesus. This is a historical fact, and it is also now a pattern at work in our lives.


John the Baptist stands for the entirety of the old covenant, everything entrusted to the Jewish people. And yet he prophetically opens the door to something entirely new in Jesus, to the revival and fulfillment of God's promises. In every generation, and in every human life, God continues to do this. He has done it through people named Augustine, Francis, Catherine, Theresa, and countless others. In my life, the Baptist's spirit has come through persons named Eric, Paul, Mary, and Ron. I challenge you to name at least three people through whom God has announced the coming of Jesus in your life. Consciously thank God for their testimony. And let's commit ourselves to listening to the spirit of John the Baptist testify again this week so that we might more strongly believe in the light.
