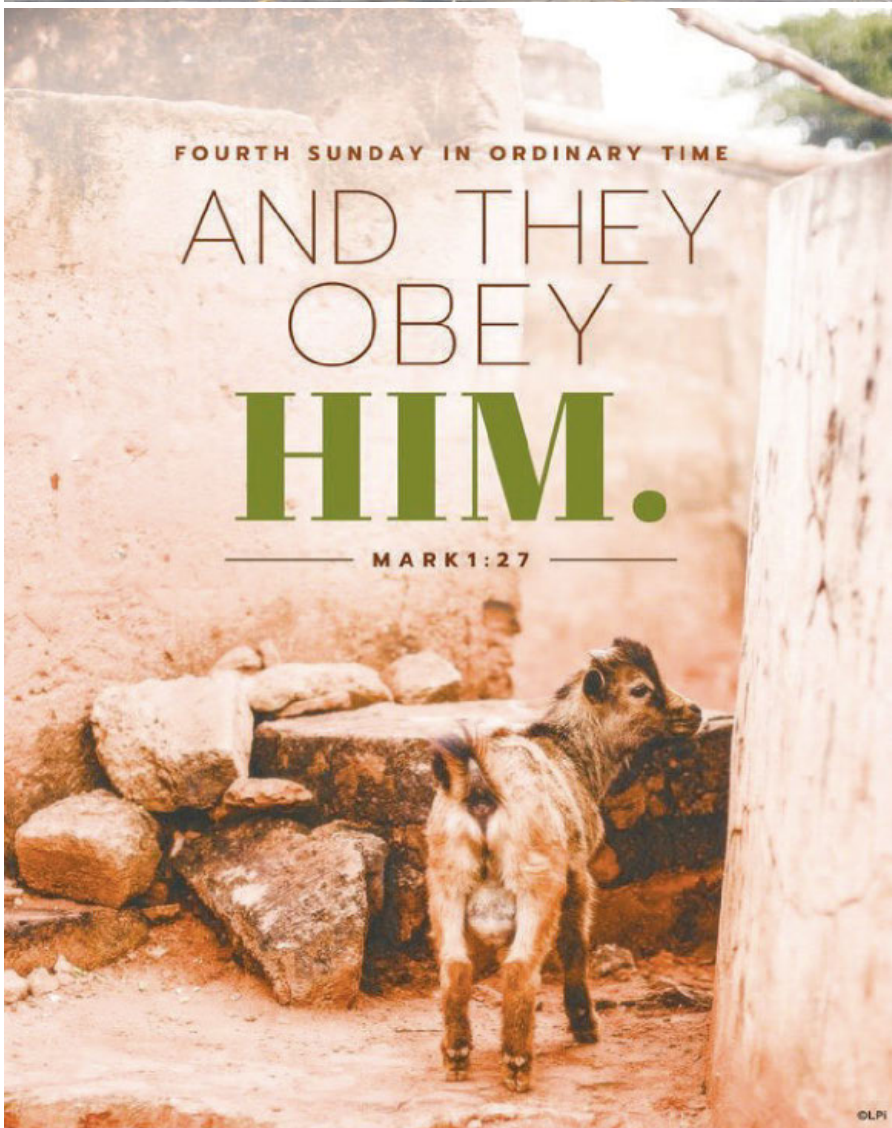

Parishioner Registration

We warmly welcome new members to St. Stephen. To register, please stop by the Parish Office during regular business hours.

Active Parishioner Status

In order to be considered as a godparent for the Sacraments of Baptism and/or a sponsor for the Sacrament of Confirmation, a person must be verified as an “active member” of a Catholic parish. While assessments of the inquiry will be made individually, the following factors are considered when making the determination of whether or not a person is an active parishioner. Is the person:

- Properly registered and supporting the Church?
- Faithfully attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days?
- Participating in parish activities when possible?
- Using the parish envelope system or electronic giving system in support of our parish?

Adult children living at home are required to register separately from their parents as parishioners.

Sacrament of Baptism

New parishioners are required to register and a baptism preparation class is required. Start the inquiry process at www.ststephentinley.com/baptism-prep

- English baptisms are celebrated at 2:30pm on the first and third Sunday of every month.
- Polish baptisms are celebrated at 2:00pm on the second Sunday of the month and during the 12:30pm Polish Mass on the fourth Sunday of the month.

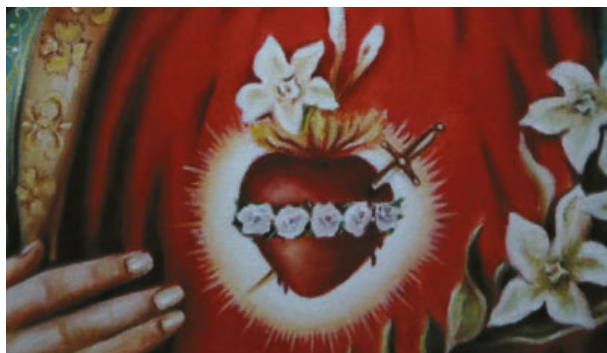

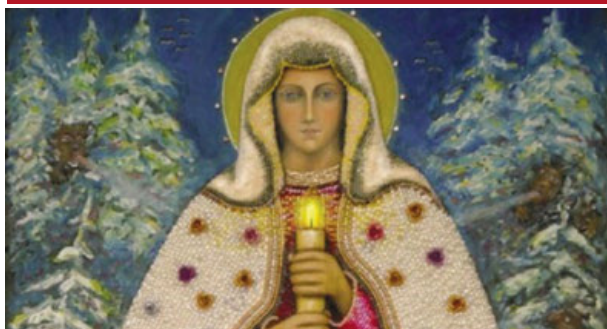

Rozważanie do liturgii z dnia 2024-02-02 Święto Ofiarowania Pańskiego



O co proszę? O miłość wierną i zdolną do największych poświęceń

Będę wpatrywał się w Maryję i Józefa, którzy przynoszą do świątyni Dzieciątka Jezus (ww. 22-24). Maryja ma świadomość, że poświęca Bogu swoje pierwsze i jedyne dziecko. Wie, że nie może zatrzymać Go dla siebie. Co mogła odczuwać jako matka? Spróbuję rozmawiać z Maryją o Jej przeżyciu w świątyni.

Będę kontemplował Maryję „Matkę pięknej miłości”, która po-trafi poświęcić Bogu najdroższą dla Niej osobę. Nie zatrzymuje dziecka przy sobie. Czy potrafię kochać osoby bez zniewalania ich sobą, bez zatrzymywania ich przy sobie? Czy nie manipuluje miłością drugiego człowieka? Czy jestem wolny od nieupo-rządkowanych przywiązań od osób i rzeczy?

Będę obserwował Symeona i Annę, którzy aż do sędziwego wieku z cierpliwością oczekują na spełnienie się Bożej obietnicy (ww. 25-38). Po wielu latach oczekiwania ich wierność zostaje nagrodzona. Co mogę powiedzieć o mojej ufności do Boga? Czy wierzę, że On nigdy nie spóźnia się ze spełnieniem swoich obietnic? Czy nie wymuszam na Bogu spełniania swoich prośb? Czy nie wątpię w Jego wierność?

Spróbuję wyobrazić sobie siebie na miejscu Symeona (w. 28). „Wezmę” od Maryi maleńkiego Jezusa i obejmę Go własnymi ramionami. Postaram się trwać w tym doświadczeniu przez dłuższy czas. Czy łatwo jest mi wyobrazić sobie siebie w takiej scenie? Jakie budzą się wtedy we mnie uczucia?

Co mogę powiedzieć o mojej więzi z Jezusem? Czy tęsknię za Jezusem? Czy szukam bliskości z Nim na modlitwie? Co naj-bardziej mi przeszkadza w budowaniu zażyłej więzi z Jezusem?

Powierzę siebie, całą moją rodzinę i wspólnotę Świętej Ro-dziny, abyśmy wzrastali w mocy, i mądrości, aby łaska Boża zawsze spoczywała nad nami.

Święto Ofiarowania Pańskiego

2 lutego obchodzone jest w Kościele święto Ofiarowania Pańskiego, potocznie zwane świętem Matki Bożej Gromniczej. Bardzo pięknie o tym święcie pisze Anselm Grün - mnich benedyktyński: "Święto Ofiarowania Pańskiego zaprasza nas, by przyjąć Chrystusa do wewnętrznej świątyni naszego serca. Wesele między Bogiem i człowiekiem odbywa się wtedy, gdy pozwalamy wejść Chrystusowi do wewnętrznej świątyni zamku naszej duszy. Znajduje to swój wyraz podczas święta w procesji ze świecami. Na rozpoczęcie Eucharystii wspólnota zbiera się w ciemnym przedsionku kościoła. Kapłan święci świece i zapala je. Następnie wszyscy wchodzi z płonącymi świecami do kościoła. Jest to obraz tego, że do świątyni naszej duszy wchodzi światło Jezusa Chrystusa i rozświetla wszystko, co jest tam jeszcze ciemne i jeszcze nie wyzwolone".

Liturgia święta Ofiarowania Pańskiego nosi cechę uroczystości oraz radości z powodu pierwszego wejścia Chrystusa do świątyni, a zarazem cechę ofiary, bowiem przychodzi On i do świątyni, aby być złożonym w ofierze. Kościół wspominając to wydarzenie zaprasza nas wszystkich do pójścia na spotkanie z Chrystusem w domu Bożym, gdzie możemy Go odnaleźć w sprawowanej Eucharystii i uczcić swego Zbawiciela, składając Mu hołd wiary i miłości, podobnych do wiary i miłości Symeona i Anny i przyjąć Go do serca. Takie znaczenie ma procesja z gromnicami: iść na spotkanie z Chrystusem - Światłością świata, z zapalonym światłem życia chrześcijańskiego.



W święto Ofiarowania Pańskiego wszyscy: zakonnice i zakonnicy, pustelnicy i świeccy konsekrowani, dziewice poświęcone Bogu i wdowy konsekrowane, obchodzą w tym roku już po raz siódmy **Dzień Życia Konsekrowanego**.

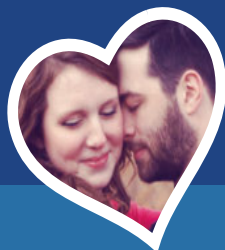
