Parishioner Registration

We warmly welcome new members to St. Stephen. To register, please stop by the Parish Office during regular business hours.

Active Parishioner Status

In order to be considered as a godparent for the Sacraments of Baptism and/or a sponsor for the Sacrament of Confirmation, a person must be verified as an “active member” of a Catholic parish. While assessments of the inquiry will be made individually, the following factors are considered when making the determination of whether or not a person is an active parishioner. Is the person:

- Properly registered and supporting the Church?
- Faithfully attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days?
- Participating in parish activities when possible?
- Using the parish envelope system or electronic giving system in support of our parish?

Adult children living at home are required to register separately from their parents as parishioners.

Sacrament of Baptism

New parishioners are required to register and a baptism preparation class is required. Start the inquiry process at www.ststephentinley.com/baptism-prep

- English baptisms are celebrated at 2:30pm on the first and third Sunday of every month.
- Polish baptisms are celebrated at 2:00pm on the second Sunday of the month and during the 12:30pm Polish Mass on the fourth Sunday of the month.

Training for Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist and Lectors

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion is the formal title of laypeople who distribute the Eucharist during Mass. This training provides all those wishing to serve in this ministry sufficient spiritual, theological and practical preparation to fulfill their role with knowledge and reverence. All ministers of Holy Communion should show the greatest reverence for the Most Holy Eucharist by their demeanor, their attire, and the manner in which they handle the consecrated bread or wine.

Lectors have a critical role in the celebration of the Mass. Since lectors proclaim not just any word, but the Word of God, it is essential that they develop the skills required to communicate God's message competently. Through the use of voice, eye contact and personal presence, lectors help God's Word come alive for the assembly. The training provides the skills and self-confidence needed for those who wish to become lectors in their parish.

Part 1 is required for *ALL MINISTERS* and is on **Tuesday, Feb 6.**

Part 2 for Training of *LECTORS* is on **Wednesday, Feb 7.** Participants will learn the theology of serving as a Liturgical Minister at Mass. Participants will also learn the practical skills necessary to proclaim the Word and serve as a Lector at Mass

Part 2 for Training of *EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS OF THE EUCHARIST* is **Thursday, Feb. 8.** This training is required by the Archdiocese for all who will become extraordinary ministers of the Eucharist in their respective parishes.

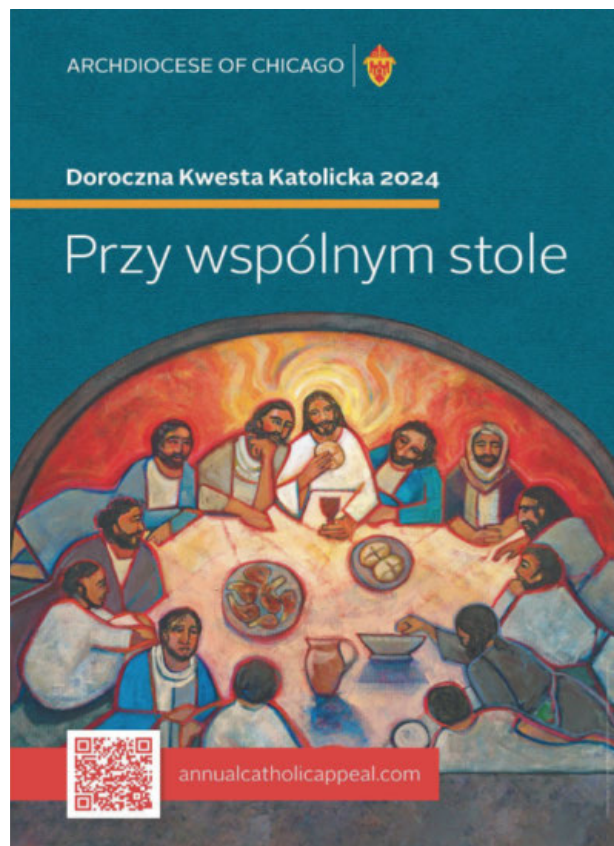

O co proszę? O głęboką wiarę, że Jezus może uzdrowić trudne sytuacje w moim domu

Ewangelia (Mk 1, 29-39)

Słowa Ewangelii według Świętego Marka

Po wyjściu z synagogi Jezus przyszedł z Jakubem i Janem do domu Szymona i Andrzeja. Teściowa zaś Szymona leżała w gorączce. Zaraz powiedzieli Mu o niej. On podszedł i podniósł ją, ująwszy za rękę, a opuściła ją gorączka. I usługiwała im.

Z nastaniem wieczora, gdy słońce zaszło, przynosili do Niego wszystkich chorych i opętanych; i całe miasto zebrało się u drzwi. Uzdrawił wielu dotkniętych rozmaitymi chorobami i wiele złych duchów wyrzucił, lecz nie pozwalał złym duchom mówić, ponieważ Go znaty.

Nad ranem, kiedy jeszcze było ciemno, wstał, wyszedł i udał się na miejsce pustynne, i tam się modlił. Pośpieszył za Nim Szymon z towarzyszami, a gdy Go znaleźli, powiedzieli Mu: «Wszyscy Cię szukają». Lecz On rzekł do nich: «Pójdźmy gdzie indziej, do sąsiednich miejscowości, abym i tam mógł nauczać, bo po to wyszedłem».

I chodził po całej Galilei, nauczając w ich synagogach i wyrzucając złe duchy. Będę kontemplował czułość i wrażliwość Jezusa spotykającego się z prostymi ludźmi. Wyobrażę sobie, jak przychodzi do domu Szymona i Andrzeja, i ujęty prośbą domowników uzdrawia teściową Piotra (ww. 29-30). Czy wierzę, że Jezus jest czuły na wszystko, co dzieje się w moim domu?

„Zbliżył się do niej i ująwszy ją za rękę, podniósł” (w. 31). W kilku słowach opisana jest niezwykła dobroć Jezusa. Podobnie jak chora w domu Szymona, tak i ja mogę doświadczać codziennie Jego uzdrawiającej bliskości. Jezus chce, abym Go o to prosił.

Przypomnę sobie chwile z mojego życia, w których wyraźnie doświadczyłem, jak Jezus przenikał mnie swoją czułą dobrocią: zbliżał się do mnie, ujmował za rękę, podnosił... W ciszy będę adorował dobroć Jezusa, jakiej doświadczyłem w moim życiu.

Wyobrażę sobie tłumy, które wieczorem przychodzą do Jezusa ze swoimi chorymi (ww. 32-34). Wierzą, że potrafi im pomóc. Dla Jezusa nie ma chorób nieuleczalnych. Potrafi pomóc każdemu. Czy w to wierzę?

Wejdę w tłum chorych, aby razem z nimi zbliżyć się do Jezusa. Czy potrafię poczuć się jak jeden spośród chorych i powiedzieć Jezusowi, że Go potrzebuję? Co jest moją największą raną? O co chciałbym prosić Jezusa?

Jezus wstaje bardzo wcześnie, „gdy jeszcze jest ciemno”, i idzie na pustynię, aby się modlić, chociaż „wszyscy Go szukają” (ww. 35-37). Będę wpatrywał się w Jezusa, który w ukryciu rozmawia ze swoim Ojcem.

Zbliżę się do Jezusa, który rozmawia ze swoim Ojcem. Poproszę Go, aby uczył mnie głębokiej i czułej więzi ze swoim Ojcem. Przyprowadzę do Niego wszystkich, którzy – dotknięci rozmaitymi chorobami – prosili mnie o modlitwę. Odmówię z miłością „Ojcze nasz”.

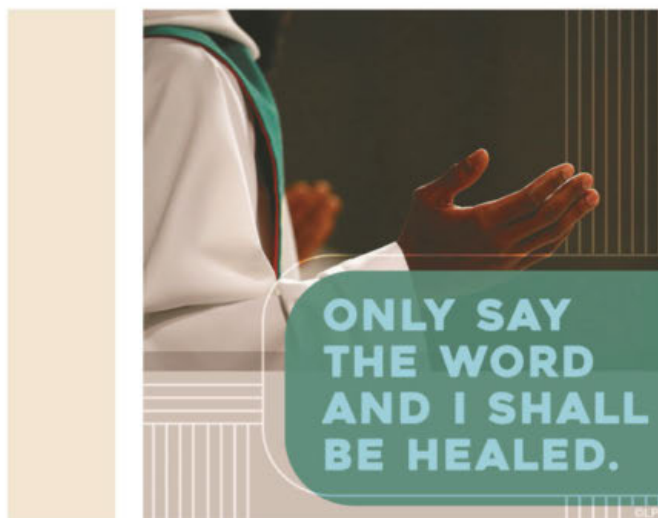

Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

Maybe I'm weird, but I like spending time in doctor's offices, confession lines in churches, auto repair shops, prison cells, and support groups of various kinds. It's refreshing to be with people who humbly admit something is wrong and forthrightly set out on a path toward a solution. When we ignore what is off kilter, we become alone and fragile. In places where people are honest and hopeful about brokenness, sturdy if subtle fellowship usually ensues.

Consider the image we see of Jesus in the Gospel of Mark. **"...they brought to him all who were ill or possessed by a demon. The whole town was gathered at the door."** The entire human community is afflicted in various ways, and so it gradually forms a strange new community around Jesus. The healer from Nazareth is like a sun of health around which orbits a throng of humanity absorbing his healing rays. These blessed souls can't fix themselves and become healthy, and they know it. But they have found in him the living source of all imaginable healing.

It's the Church, isn't it? A sin-sick community gathered and healed is what happens at the beginning of every Mass. We shuffle in through the door from everywhere and announce that we are not okay, and we can't fix it. In doing so, we are drawn into the orbit of the healing power of Christ — and into a renewed community with the whole human family. It's nothing to fear or rush. Maybe we can even learn to enjoy more how good it is to be in such a happy place.

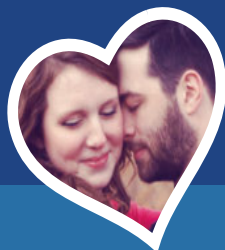

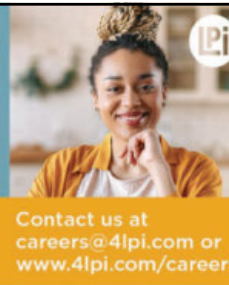

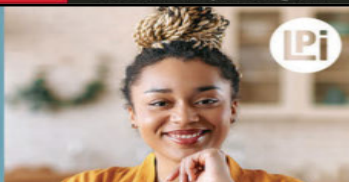
