We warmly welcome new members to St. Stephen. To register, please stop by the Parish Office during regular business hours.

Active Parishioner Status

In order to be considered as a godparent for the Sacraments of Baptism and/or a sponsor for the Sacrament of Confirmation, a person must be verified as an "active member" of a Catholic parish. While assessments of the inquiry will be made individually, the following factors are considered when making the determination of whether or not a person is an active parishioner. Is the person:

- Properly registered and supporting the Church?
- Faithfully attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days?
- Participating in parish activities when possible?
- Using the parish envelope system or electronic giving system in support of our parish?

Adult children living at home are required to register separately from their parents as parishioners.

- English baptisms are celebrated at 2:30pm on the first and third Sunday of every month.

Rozważanie do liturgii z dnia 2024-03-03

Ewangelia (J 2, 13-25)

O co proszę? O radykalne oczyszczenie serca z moich grzechów

O to proszę: O radykamie oczyszczemie serca z molen grzecii



Zbliżała się pora Paschy żydowskiej i Jezus przybył do Jerozolimy. W świątyni zastał siedzących za stołami bankierów oraz tych, którzy sprzedawali woły, baranki i gołębie. Wówczas, sporządziwszy sobie bicz ze sznurów, powypędzał wszystkich ze świątyni, także baranki i woły, porozrzucał monety bankierów, a stoły powywracał. Do tych zaś, którzy sprzedawali gołębie, rzekł: «Zabierzcie to stąd i z domu mego Ojca nie róbcie targowiska!» Uczniowie Jego przypomnieli sobie, że napisano: «Gorliwość o dom Twój pochłonie Mnie».

W odpowiedzi zaś na to Żydzi rzekli do Niego: «Jakim znakiem wykażesz się wobec nas, skoro takie rzeczy czynisz?» Jezus dał im taką odpowiedź: «Zburzcie tę świątynię, a Ja w trzy dni wzniosę ją na nowo».

Powiedzieli do Niego Żydzi: «Czterdzieści sześć lat budowano tę świątynię, a Ty ją wzniesiesz w przeciągu trzech dni?»

On zaś mówił o świątyni swego ciała. Gdy zmartwychwstał, przypomnieli sobie uczniowie Jego, że to powiedział, i uwierzyli Pismu i słowu, które wyrzekł Jezus.

Kiedy zaś przebywał w Jerozolimie w czasie Paschy, w dniu świątecznym, wielu uwierzyło w Jego imię, widząc znaki, które czynił. Jezus natomiast nie zawierzał im samego siebie, bo wszystkich znał i nie potrzebował niczyjego świadectwa o człowieku. Sam bowiem wiedział, co jest w człowieku. Będę towarzyszył Jezusowi idącemu do Jerozolimy na święto Paschy (w. 13). Wchodzi do świątyni, która jest dla Niego najdroższym miejscem na ziemi – domem Ojca. W serdecznej rozmowie będę Go pytał o Jego miłość do Ojca, o Jego przeżycia na krótko przed męką.

Przypomnę sobie moją świątynię: kościół czy kaplicę, w której przebywam najczęściej. Czy jest dla mnie domem Ojca? Czy chętnie w niej przebywam? Czy szukam umocnienia u Ojca, gdy nadchodzi cierpienie?

Wyobraźnią zbliżę się do świątyni, przed którą stoją stragany i kupczący. Usłyszę zgiełk handlarzy. Zobaczę, jak gwałtownie wzbiera gniew Jezusa. Biczem wyrzuca kupczących i wywraca stoły bankierów (ww. 14-15). Świątynia należy całkowicie do Ojca i Jego spraw! (ww. 16-17).

Będę rozmawiał z Jezusem o tamtym wydarzeniu. Poproszę Go, aby dał mi serce wrażliwe i delikatne na wszystko, co święte, bym nigdy nie wykorzystywał Boga dla własnych korzyści.

Świątynie z cegły przypominają mi o świątyni ducha (ww. 18-21). Ilekroć wchodzę do miejsca świętego, tylekroć Bóg przypomina mi, że On sam chce przebywać we mnie. Uświadomię sobie, że Jezus codziennie przychodzi do mnie i pyta o stan świątyni mojego ciała. Wie, co się kryje w moim sercu (w. 25).

Jakie spojrzenie Jezusa jawi się w mojej wyobraźni, gdy myślę, że patrzy teraz w moje wnętrze: radosne czy smutne? Co mogę powiedzieć o moim duchowym samopoczuciu? Co dominuje w moim wnętrzu: klimat pokoju i modlitwy czy zgiełku i targowiska?

Jezus ma moc odbudować świątynię mego serca, nawet gdyby była zrujnowana przez grzech. Może ożywić najbardziej martwe i zdrętwiałe wnętrze. Zaproszę Jezusa do siebie słowami: "Daj mi serce nowe!".

Gospel Meditation Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

I am the Lord your God ... You shall not have other gods beside me. -Ex 20:2-3

One of the greatest golfers of all time — if not the greatest — was Jack Nicklaus. Which is why it is baffling that at the beginning of each season he would return to his childhood coach and re-learn how to grip the golf club. It's like Shakespeare re-learning the alphabet and grammar. Why would he do that? Because Jack knew that the fundamentals are always relevant. Perfecting and obsessing over his grip allowed him to do everything else in the game well. In sports and life, the best ones love the basics.

Similarly, as we begin Lent, we re-learn the spiritual basics in the Ten Commandments. Consider the first, to "have no other gods besides me." This is our "grip." Is our connection to God one of absolute fidelity and exclusive worship? Am I willing to let go of my precious idols, the things I cling to instead of God? Once we say "yes" to this fundamental question of our spiritual "grip," then we are ready to properly engage with everything else in life. Watch how beautifully the game of life unfolds in the next nine commandments (numbered in parentheses): how we speak to God and others (2 and 8), how we organize our week (3), how we relate to our family (4) and the wider community (5 and 7), how we live our sexuality (6), and how we order all the other desires of the human heart (9 and 10). But don't rush to these later Commandments too soon! Everything in life is built on the first Commandment. The more we focus on worshiping God alone, the better we navigate the complexity of life with panache, effectiveness, and love.

Lenten challenge: This week, identify what you can do to better worship God alone. If you're not sure, scan the last nine commandments to identify what you are most likely to worship instead of God. Power, pleasure, control of your time, possessions, family, health, reputation, money? Commit to concrete action to help you let go of this "idol" to better hold on to God alone in faithful worship. Remember: the best love the basics.
