#### **Parishioner Registration**

We warmly welcome new members to St. Stephen. To register, please stop by the Parish Office during regular business hours.

#### **Active Parishioner Status**

In order to be considered as a godparent for the Sacraments of Baptism and/or a sponsor for the Sacrament of Confirmation, a person must be verified as an "active member" of a Catholic parish. While assessments of the inquiry will be made individually, the following factors are considered when making the determination of whether or not a person is an active parishioner. Is the person:

- Properly registered and supporting the Church?
- Faithfully attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days?
- Participating in parish activities when possible?
- Using the parish envelope system or electronic giving system in support of our parish?

Adult children living at home are required to register separately from their parents as parishioners.

#### Sacrament of Baptism

New parishioners are required to register and a baptism preparation class is required. Start the inquiry process at <a href="https://www.ststephentinley.com/baptism-prep">www.ststephentinley.com/baptism-prep</a>

- English baptisms are celebrated at 2:30pm on the first and third Sunday of every month.
- Polish baptisms are celebrated at 2:00pm on the second Sunday of the month and during the 12:30pm Polish Mass on the fourth Sunday of the month.

#### Rozważanie do liturgii z dnia 2024-03-17

O co proszę? O głęboką więź z Jezusem, zaufanie Mu i wierne kroczenie Jego drogami

#### Ewangelia (J 12, 20-33)

Wśród tych, którzy przybyli, aby oddać pokłon Bogu w czasie święta, byli też niektórzy Grecy. Oni więc przystąpili do Filipa, pochodzącego z Betsaidy Galilejskiej, i prosili go, mówiąc: «Panie, chcemy ujrzeć Jezusa». Filip poszedł i powiedział Andrzejowi. Z kolei Andrzej i Filip poszli i powiedzieli Jezusowi.

A Jezus dał im taką odpowiedź: «Nadeszła godzina, aby został otoczony chwałą Syn Człowieczy. Zaprawdę, zaprawdę, powiadam wam: Jeśli ziarno pszenicy, wpadłszy w ziemię, nie obumrze, zostanie samo jedno, ale jeśli obumrze, przynosi plon obfity. Ten, kto kocha swoje życie, traci je, a kto nienawidzi swego życia na tym świecie, zachowa je na życie wieczne. Kto zaś chciałby Mi służyć, niech idzie za Mną, a gdzie Ja jestem, tam będzie i mój sługa. A jeśli ktoś Mi służy, uczci go mój Ojciec.

Teraz dusza moja doznała lęku i cóż mam powiedzieć? Ojcze, wybaw Mnie od tej godziny. Ależ właśnie dlatego przyszedłem na tę godzinę. Ojcze, wsław imię Twoje!»

Wtem rozległ się głos z nieba: «Już wsławiłem i jeszcze wsławię». Stojący tłum to usłyszał i mówił: «Zagrzmiało!» Inni mówili: «Anioł przemówił do Niego». Na to rzekł Jezus: «Głos ten rozległ się nie ze względu na Mnie, ale ze względu na was. Teraz odbywa się sąd nad tym światem. Teraz władca tego świata zostanie wyrzucony precz. A Ja, gdy zostanę nad ziemię wywyższony, przyciągnę wszystkich do siebie». To mówił, oznaczając, jaką śmiercią miał umrzeć.

Na początku medytacji poproszę Jezusa, aby pomógł mi zbadać więź, jak mnie z Nim łączy. Dlaczego wierzę w Jezusa? Dlaczego idę za Nim?

"Panie, chcemy ujrzeć Jezusa" (w. 21). Zauważę, jak wielkie jest pragnienie Greków, którzy chcą zobaczyć Jezusa z bliska. Przywołam doświadczenie mojej pierwszej miłości, zauroczenie, radość, które mi wtedy towarzyszyły.

Jezus przygotowuje uczniów do swojej męki. Wsłucham się uważnie w słowa Jezusa o obumieraniu ziarna i o traceniu życia (ww. 24-25). Jakie odczucia budzą w moim sercu? Czego boję się w moim życiu utracić? Jakie przywiązania jeszcze we mnie nie obumarły?

"Gdzie ja jestem, tam będzie i mój sługa" (w. 26). Czy mogę dzisiaj powiedzieć, że poszedłbym za Jezusem wszędzie? W jakich sytuacjach jestem Mu najbardziej wierny, a w jakich niewierny? Przejdę z Jezusem wszystkie miejsca i sytuacje mojej wierności i niewierności. Oddam Mu siebie na nowo.

Zauważę, że Jezus – zapowiadając swoją mękę – przyznaje się do lęku (ww. 27-28). Nie chce jednak uciekać od godziny, którą przeznaczył Mu Ojciec. Wejdę z Jezusem w moje osobiste lęki. Będę Go prosił o wewnętrzną wolność od wszelkich lęków, które kuszą mnie do ucieczki.

Na krótko przed męką Jezus słyszy głos Ojca, który przypomina mu o Jego niepodzielnym panowaniu nad historią świata i moją osobistą (ww. 28-31). Nawet w chwilach największych doświadczeń nic nie wymyka się z Jego rąk. Moja wierność zostanie nagrodzona.



W modlitwie przed Jezusem ukrzyżowanym będę prosił, pomny na Jego obietnicę, aby przyciągnął mnie do siebie i na nowo rozmiłował w sobie i w Ojcu. Będę prosił, aby Duch Jezusa pomógł mi razem z Nim modlić się w sercu: "Abba, Ojcze, Tatusiu!".

#### **Planting Seeds – Farm Update**

You've probably noticed that all the buildings have been removed from the farm property south of our parking lot. Parishioners, as well as neighbors of our parish, have had nothing but good things to say about the property. So, what's next?

Seeds are being planted to begin a modest prayer garden. Landscaping companies and landscape architects have been consulted, but it's been decided to move slowly on this garden. No one wants to add something to the area that may need to be demolished, sooner rather than later.

The parish has been able to obtain three outdoor statues from a Catholic high school that closed, and a church that closed and merged with another parish as part of Renew My Church. Rather than see those statues scrapped or destroyed, we've asked that they be relocated to our prayer garden. We are not being charged for the statues, but we will pay to have them moved.

Sometime this spring it's hoped that you'll be able to see the placement of the statues and some benches strategically located in the shade of trees, where parishioners will be able to peacefully enjoy the natural setting God has provided while praying in thanksgiving for all that He has given to us.

#### **Gospel Meditation**

#### **Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture**

A middle-aged woman sat on the couch in my parish office and recounted to me a shocking list of terrible calamities in her life: addictions, terminal illnesses, financial loss, broken relationships, and so on. She smiled as she did so. "Please forgive me," I asked, "but you seem to be smiling as you share this." She said, "Father John, I am totally overwhelmed. But I'm smiling because I just can't wait to see what good things God does with this mess." She expected God would manifest His glory when she most needed it.

This week in the Gospel, God speaks from heaven for the third and final time in Jesus' earthly ministry. It's at a tough moment. Gentiles seek Jesus, who announces his terrible suffering, and then boldly prays, "Father, glorify your name!" John then writes: Then a voice came from heaven, "I have glorified it and will glorify it again." Was the task of drawing the whole non-Jewish world to himself overwhelming? Or was it the terrible specter of crucifixion? Whatever it was, the crushing weight triggers his turning to the Father with an unshakeable expectation of divine glory to burst through. And indeed, it did on Easter Sunday. In our burdens, our greatest strength is to turn to God and boldly ask Him for His glory.

**Lenten challenge:** This week, I invite you to list out everything which is a burden to you. Write it down. Then add these words: "Father, glorify Your name in all these things!" Put that paper in your pocket or purse when you come to Holy Week liturgies next week. You might smile at the most unlikely times.
