We've begun the month of October, dedicated to Mary, Our Lady of the Rosary. Oct. 13th is the 100th anniversary of the final apparition to the three children at Fatima, Portugal. Our parish visitation statue is still being hosted by our families. St. Dominic in 1206 began the rosary by meditating on the events in the lives of Jesus and Mary. The 20 meditations that comprise the Rosary are: the Joyous, Luminous, Sorrowful and Glorious Mysteries.
