Tragedies, such as the hateful and premeditated slaughter of fifty New Zealanders in two mosques, absolutely are an affront to the world community. It brings only sorrow, loss of loved ones, and fuels hate speech within and towards diverse communities. Now, instead of lamb and kiwis, we'll think of carnage and death. We pray for their untimely passage to the God of Abraham. May they rest in peace. Closer to home, last weekend a Jewish cemetery in Fall River was vandalized and desecrated with pro-Nazi graffiti. Conversion is needed all around and within us this Lenten Season.

We are so blessed to welcome to our parish **Father Timothy Reilly**, the Chancellor of the Diocese of Providence. When I expressed my desire to return to parish life in 2007, Bishop Tobin asked me who would be a possible successor. I had only one priest in mind, Fr. Reilly. He was a member of the CYO when I was at St. Brendan's from 1986-1992. We asked him last year to join us this Lent. Welcome, Fr, Reilly.

Fr. Reilly has chosen as his theme:

"OFFER IT UP:

OUR PARENTS WERE RIGHT AFTER ALL!"

He will reflect on the age-old "problem" of human suffering, and why the key to our sanity (and sanctity!) is to connect our sufferings to the Cross of Jesus. We will also look at how some of the saints handled suffering in their own lives. We gather on Sunday, Monday and Tuesday evenings at 7 PM. Please invite your family, neighbors, and friends to join us for these timely Lenten reflections on a human reality that is transformed only by Christ's own passion, death and Resurrection.
