

We are within the month of the church being closed for renovation beginning on Monday, Nov. 4. All three Weekend Masses on November 9/10 will be celebrated at Wannamoisett Country Club. Daily Mass at 8 AM will be celebrated at Our Lady of Loreto in the center of East Providence. All interior work will be completed before Thanksgiving. It's all possible because of the very positive response by our grateful parishioners of St. Margaret's. There will be updates each week throughout the Campaign.

I hope you found the Grateful for God's Providence information video to be a clear and well done presentation of the goals for the \$50 million campaign. Our parish co-chairs, Art and Paula DeBlois, stated it very succinctly,...to the effect, it's our turn as committed and active members of the Catholic Church to hand over to our children and grandchildren not only the faith, but also the ministerial heritage we have received. Jesus said, "What you received as a gift, give as a gift." This entire campaign is to deepen, strengthen and preserve the parish and larger diocesan ministries. All I can do is to ask each parishioner to pray for our efforts. Please consider a stretch gift over 4 years to help us reach our parish goal of \$491,000. Whatever we raise, St. Margaret's will receive 40% of what comes in. The over goal share is 60% that will remain at St. Margaret's.

There's much going on in the parish and in the Rumford community. The St. Margaret School NOVEMBER CALENDAR fund raiser is important for our great parish school. Calendars are \$10 and a winner will be drawn every day of November. They are available though our students, at the school, and at the parish office.
