THE PASTOR'S CORNER

After the *early and unwelcomed snowfall*, (even sooner than for my friends in Switzerland), we have only a few more weeks in this liturgical year. Today's parable of the oil lamp has visited some parishioners this year. No one knows the day nor the hour...each day, each moment **is** a gift. Cherish life, live life, protect life, and give thanks for life. Unfortunately, too many folks have deep regrets... not appreciating their parents or children, ignoring their friends in need, taking our health for granted until it's compromised, etc., etc. Celebrate and give thanks for the gift of life...in the body and in the Spirit.

I write this the morning of the election. We can only pray that our entire nation will accept the results, work for justice, and always pray for peace. We plead for wisdom, courage, and unity. Our first reading describes Lady Wisdom waiting at the city gates to instruct all those humble enough to seek her. Wisdom was present at creation when she danced across the newly created earth (Proverbs 8:29-31).

Wisdom is one of the seven-fold gifts of the Spirit. Bishop Tobin has given pastors the canonical authority to celebrate the sacrament this year. With permission, I will celebrate Confirmation on Monday and Thursday evenings. As the late Bishop Mulvee always said at Confirmation ceremonies, "I can only offer you the seven gifts of the Spirit. Will you use them? Only God and you will know." Our thanks to Mr. Moreira who taught our students for the past two years. The parish wishes our newly confirmed the blessings of the Spirit as they continue their high school years and plan for their exciting future.

Deacon Needham is resting well after a medical procedure. He will be preaching for us very soon. Deacon David Gillis, introduced at the 10:30 Mass last Sunday, is resting after shoulder surgery. He has an impressive *curriculum vitae* that he will share with you in the weeks ahead. Our prayers to both our parish deacons and their ministry at St. Margaret's.

Thank you for being so co-operative with parish protocols for combating the COVID virus! I know that we are all fatigued with the election, with COVID, and with the intrusion into our personal, family, and parish lives. You encourage and strengthen me, Deacons Needham and Gillis, our parish and school staffs in pursuing the safest way to serve you at St. Margaret's. Be faithful, be strong, be considerate of others, and as the great St. Paul encouraged those to whom he wrote; "Be holy!"
