

### THE PASTOR'S CORNER

This was a special week for our wonderful parish. Our youth adults were fully initiated into the faith with the reception of Confirmation. Congratulations to them, their parents and others who supported them. A special word of thanks to Mr. Charlies Moreira, their teacher for the past two years. United with Baptism and Holy Eucharist, Confirmation strengthens their Christian faith, and helps them with the opportunity to deepen it in their daily lives. We pray they will further the work and ministry of the Church.

We are very pleased to welcome the Most Reverend Robert Evans, Auxiliary Bishop of Providence, for the 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary of our parish church at the 10:30 Mass. Bishop Evans lived here in residence just after the fire from 1989 to 1991. Years later, I followed him as Chancellor and Personnel Director. He then he returned to those diocesan responsibilities after his consecration as Auxiliary Bishop. This is where the job switch ends! Welcome, Bishop Evans, and thank you for celebrating the Holy Eucharist for us, as well as your episcopal ministry in the Diocese of Providence. *Ad multos annos!* 

I attended the East Providence Zoning Board on Nov. 4th to speak on my petition for a zoning variance for a new digital parish sign. It will replace the present, dated and aging one that is north of the rectory on Pawtucket Avenue. My sincere appreciation to Attorney Greg Dias and our Parish Trustee, John C. Lynch, who accompanied me to the meeting. With three elementary schools within a mile of the sign (St. Margaret School, Myron J. Francis Elementary School, and the Wolf School), I informed the Board that the sign also will be used to provide immediate Amber and Silver Alerts in Rumford. We are the church with that capability. Also, a word of thanks to the *silent donors*, who are making this great addition a reality to our parish. The appropriate permits are being sought, and the new sign will be hopefully operational by the end of the year. You will find it very attractive, appropriate for the ministry and mission of our parish and school, and it will be neither visually obtrusive to our neighbors, nor distracting to motorists. More news as the project proceeds.

Finally, get your turkey for Thanksgiving, wear a mask, and be grateful for our wonderful parish.
