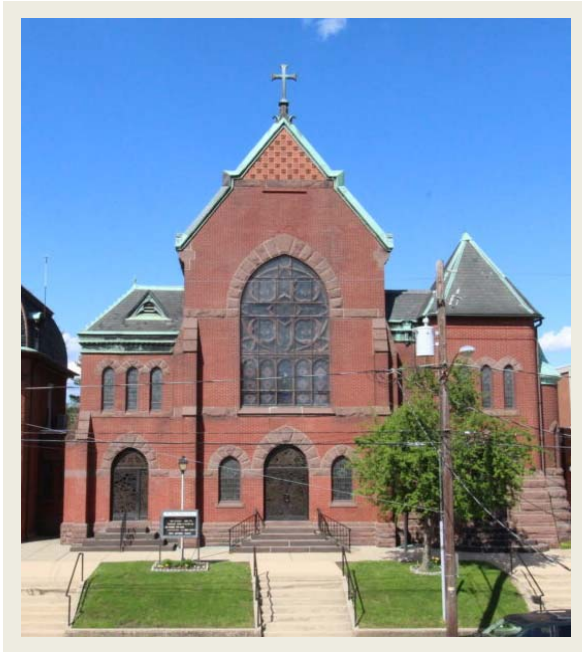

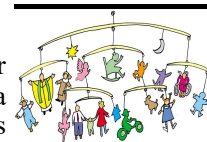


RELIGIOUS EDUCATION
