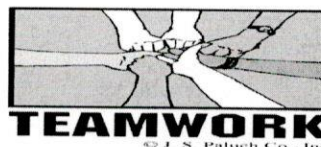
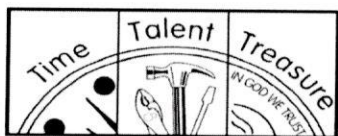
Liturgical Commission

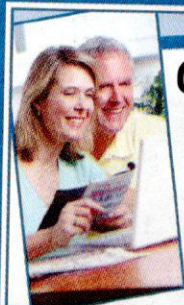
