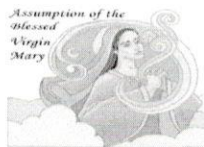

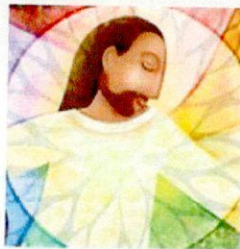
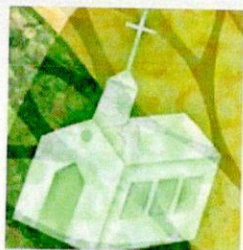

Faith Formation

On-line Registration

Calling all students (and their parents)! It is time to register for Religious Education (RE). This year we have made it more simple by offering an on-line registration in both English and Spanish. If you are already giving to the parish through ParishSOFT Giving, you can use your current logon to pay for RE by credit or debit or by using a direct withdrawal from your checking or savings account. If you have not registered with ParishSoft Giving, you will have to register before you can pay on-line. If you cannot pay using one of those options, you can still come into the office and pay by cash or check. For anyone who cannot use the on-line registration, there will be a 1-day registration on Aug **24** from **8:00** to **11:00**. All moneys are due by the first day of class (Sep 8 for 6-18, Sep 10 for PK - 5). If you still owe money from 2018-2019, that is also due by the first day of class and can be paid in the office. Please note that there will be late fees for any child who signs up after religious education classes have commenced. Don't wait! 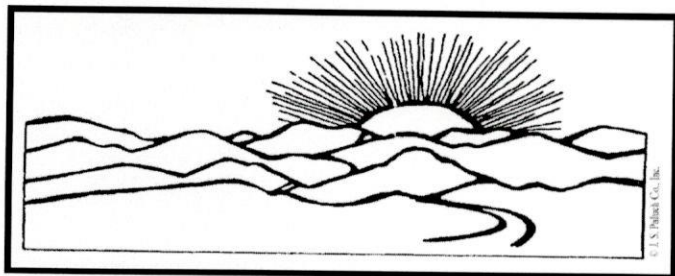

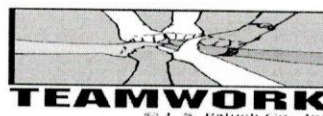

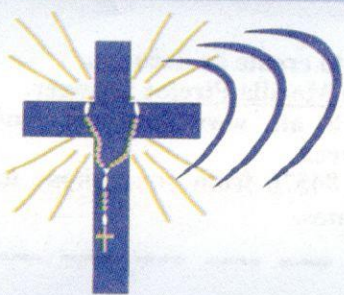
