

From the Catholic Chaplain Corp...

An act of spiritual communion, which has been recommended by saints who were masters of the spiritual life, is "an ardent desire to receive Jesus in the most holy Sacrament and lovingly embrace Him" (St. Thomas Aquinas) at a time or in circumstances when one cannot receive Him in Sacramental Communion. Spiritual communion requires the same disposition as the actual reception of the Sacrament and a turning to Jesus with the heart.

Here is a prayer to say when you can't receive communion:

"My Jesus, I believe that you are present in the Blessed Sacrament. I love you above all things and I desire you with all my heart. Since I cannot now receive you sacramentally, I ask you to come spiritually into my heart. I embrace you as if you were already in my heart and unite myself to you completely. Please do not let me ever be separated from you." - St. Alphonsus Liguori
