
Marriage: Arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least 6 months before the desired date. The couple is required to complete the preparatory programs. Call the office for more information.

DID YOU KNOW?

Lent is traditionally divided into 2 parts: the first begins on Ash Wednesday, called "the beginning of the fasting days" and ends on the Saturday before Passion Sunday, consisting of the "Great Fortnight" known as Passiontide. The first half of Lent is focused on "us", our sinfulness and need for repentance. This helps us to focus on interior renewal, preparing our hearts to receive the light of Christ into our lives. The second half turns our gaze onto the suffering Christ. We begin to enter into His Passion leading up to His betrayal and death. This helps us to understand the results of our sins and the amazing love Jesus has for us, that led Him to willingly give up His life for sinners. These two parts of Lent help us prepare our hearts for the great feast of Easter, when Jesus Christ conquered death and opened to us the gates of Heaven.



SACRAMENTS

Baptisms: To support our families in preparing for baptism, our parish requires participation in a baptismal preparation process. This process includes completion and submission of a Baptismal Registration form and the child's birth certificate as well as an interview and participation in a Baptismal Preparation class for the parents and godparents.

Marriages: Arrangements need to be made with the priest at least 6 months in advance. An archdiocesan approved Pre-Cana program must be completed.

Quinceañeras: The young lady must be registered and attending Religious Education classes at their parish for at least one year before their Quinceañera Mass is scheduled.
