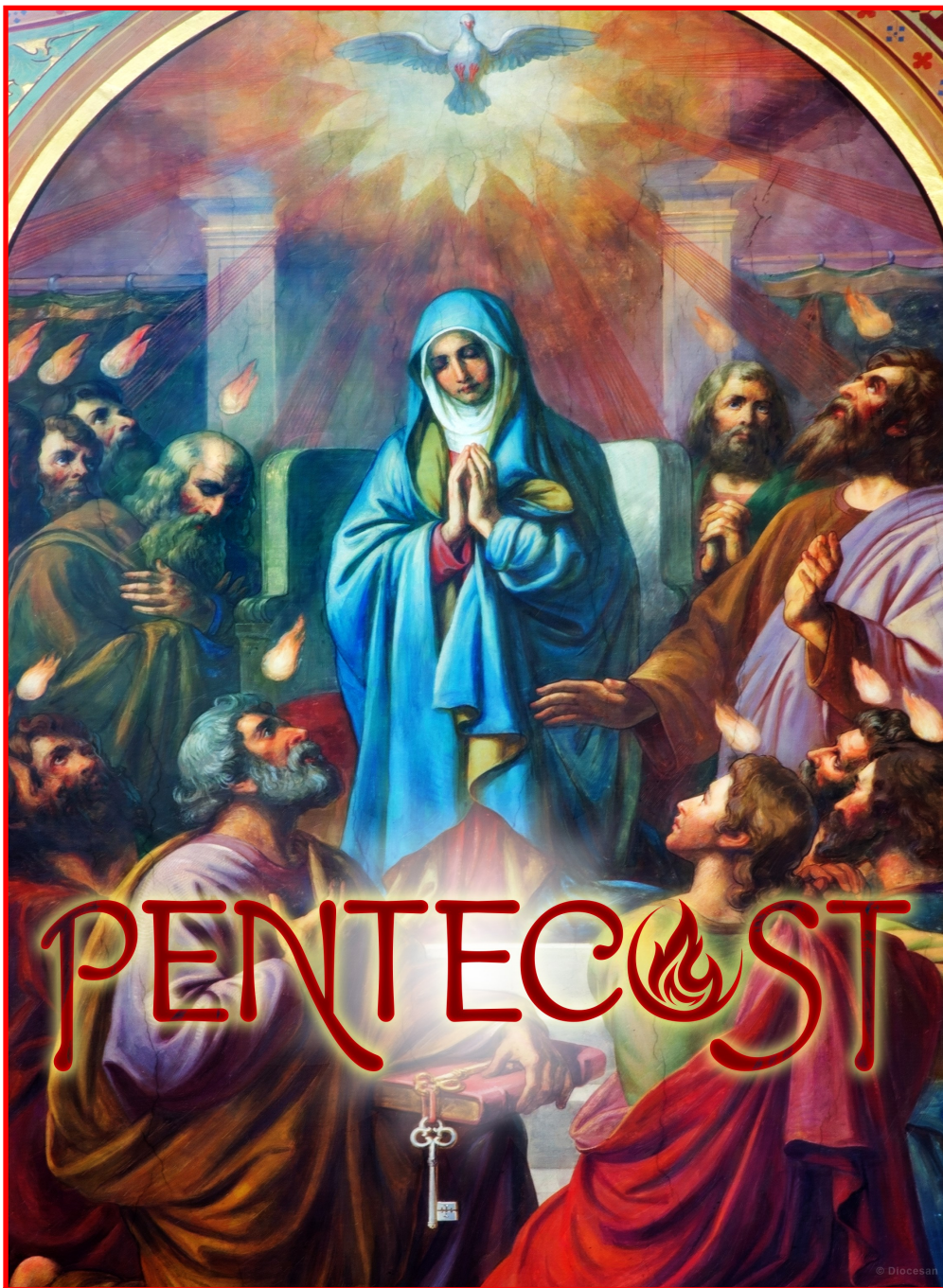

CHARITAS CORNER UPDATE

"Helping those in need through God's greatness and your generosity."

In the spirit of God's graciousness in helping those less fortunate, the *Charitas Fund* recently provided assistance on two occasions. First, a university student was temporarily struggling financially and needed assistance to pay her rent for a month until she got paid from her new job. A one-time payment was made to her landlord. The second case involved a donation to an entity serving a demographic of abortion vulnerable pregnant women who choose life. The funds will provide much needed maternity clothes for these women as well as baby necessities and clothing. The recipients expressed their sincere gratitude, especially in light of the current inflated prices and short supply of baby items.

Additionally, as we do for all recipients, our members offered their prayers for these individuals as a part of our spirituality ministry. St. Francis of Paola has called all of us to be "humble of heart" and it is in our opinion that these recipients embody this quality in a way we may never appreciate. Your continued support and generosity helped make these -- and other acts of kindness -- happen.

The Charitas Fund is administered by the San Franciscani Society and funded primarily through the second collection, usually on the third Sunday of each month. The purpose of this Fund is to assist recipients who, through no fault of their own, have fallen on hard times and have a documented need for assistance in getting back on their feet. The Fund is a source of a one-time donation to a recipient. Frequently, requests for assistance far exceed the monies available, and this prevents the Fund from helping all those in need. This is the reason why we ask for your continued support through your generous donations!

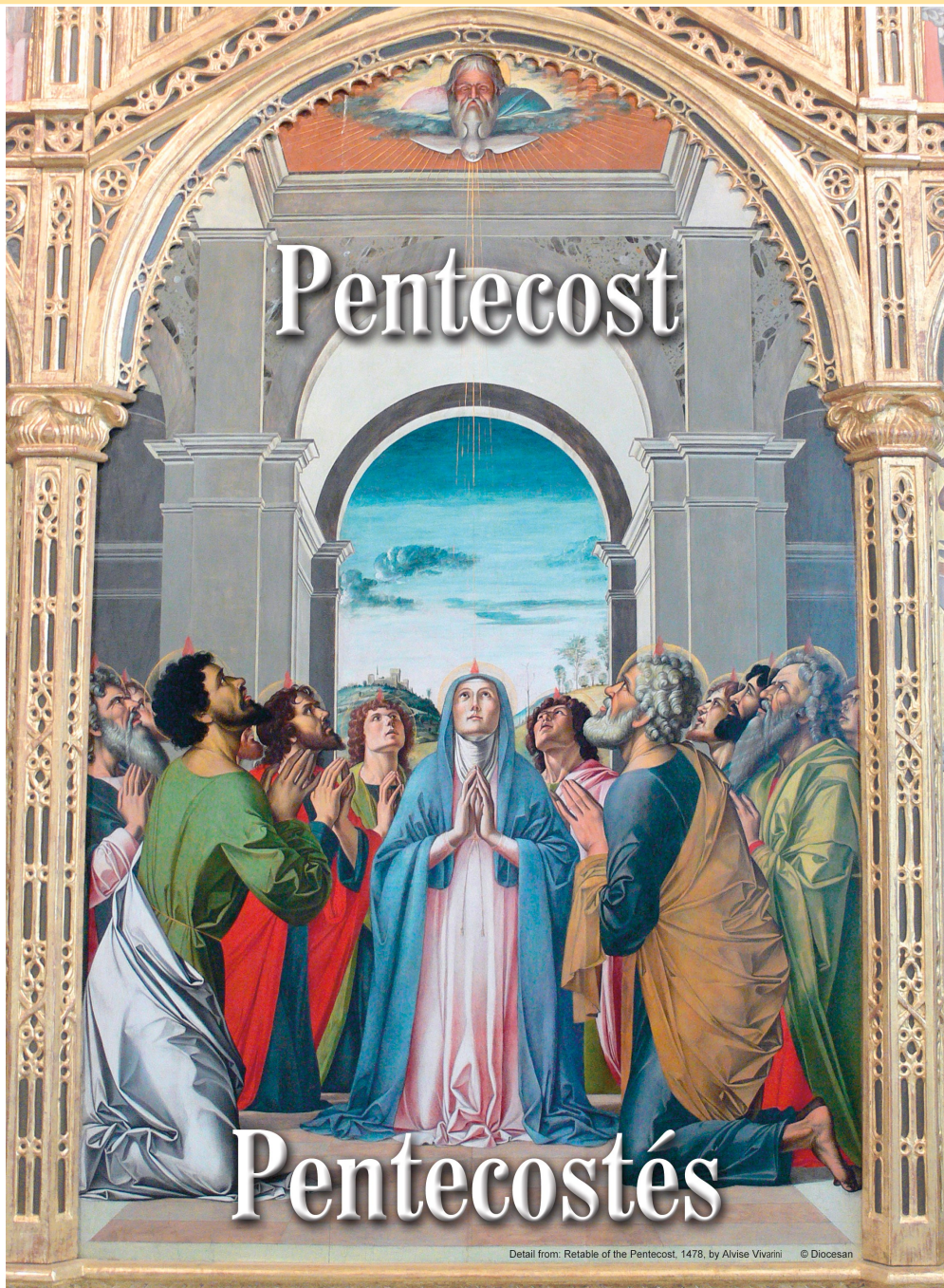
