

#### FIRST SATURDAY DEVOTION

#### Saturday, May 6 at San Francesco di Paola

This devotion was requested by Our Lady of Fatima.
On December 10, 1925, Our Lady and the Child
Jesus appeared to Sr. Lucia. The Christ Child said,
"Have compassion on the Heart of your most holy
Mother."

The five first Saturdays correspond to the five types of offenses and blasphemies committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary. This is a beautiful expression of love helping us to grow closer to the Blessed Mother and to pray for the conversion of sinners and for peace in the world.

The conditions for the First Saturday Devotion are:

- Go to confession, 8 days before or after
- Receive Holy Communion
- Pray 5 decades of the Holy Rosary
- Meditate for 15 minutes on the Mysteries of the Holy Rosary

The last two conditions will take place at San Francesco di Paola along with the Holy Presence of the Blessed Sacrament. At 2pm, Fr. Krikor Chahin will give a talk about the Blessed Mother. At 3pm, we will begin the Our Lady of Fatima devotion followed by Mass at 4pm. Join us—all are welcome!


