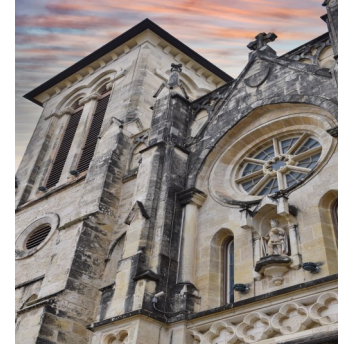

Drywall Repair


Changing light bulbs

Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time

In today's Gospel, Christ calls us to share his Good News-to speak what we know of him out in the world, to be a sign of hope, and to not be afraid, for he watches over us. We are, in effect, called to do as Jesus did. The Gospel is meant for all. In word and deed, we disciples are sent to spread the Good News. Reflect on the gifts you have been given for sharing the love of Christ. Are you a "doer"? Do you have a gift for practical service? For discerning people's needs? For conversion? For hospitality? How can you use your gifts to share the Good News?

Unfortunately, late last week, the compressor completely went out. Monies from the proceeds of our Fiesta San Fernando 2023 will assist in providing the additional money needed for these projects. Thank you for your generosity and expect to see some large trucks moving new units onto our property soon.
