#### Registering is important because:


- If a parish doesn't know who is out there, how can it adequately serve the needs of all especially singles, divorced or young families who may not see the need to register?

Please join us on October 7th at San Fernando Cathedral for First Saturday Devotion requested by Our Lady of Fatima in reparation to the offenses committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary, to pray for the conversion of sinners, and peace in the world. We will start with Saturday Mass at 5:00 pm followed by the Holy Presence of the Blessed Sacrament, thereafter with the Holy Rosary prayer, and conclude with meditating on the mysteries of the Holy Rosary. The request for the First Saturday Devotion by Our Lady are the following:

- Receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation 8 days before or after the first Saturday. Visit sfeathedral.org for Reconciliation schedule
- Receive Holy Communion on the first Saturday of the month. San Fernando Cathedral Saturday Mass begins at 5:00 pm
  - Pray the Holy Rosary
  - Meditate for 15 minutes on the Mysteries of the Holy Rosary.


