



#### **Pastoral Council Openings**

San Fernando Cathedral and San Francesco di Paola will be selecting new Pastoral Council members this December. Are you interested? The Pastoral Council meets regularly and offers an opportunity for the faithful, with their pastors, to share in the co-responsibility of the parish community, working together in a spirit of *synodality* and *pastoral de conjunto*. Parish Pastoral Councils offer their voice to pastors as representative of the greater parish community. The council exists as a consultative body only. Once recommendations have been made, and the pastor has decided on a course of action, other constituent groups will be included in planning and implementation of the pastoral plan as needed, developing goals and a proper evaluation process where appropriate. San Fernando has four openings and San Francesco di Paola has two openings. Terms are usually set for three years, at most. If you are interested in serving your parish and church in this manner, please see or give your name to Fr. Carlos so that he can include you in the discerning process. The Holy Spirit will draw the names of our new Pastoral Council members at Mass on December 25, 2023.
