





Father's Footnotes Solemnity of Our Lord, Jesus Christ King of the Universe-November 26, 2023

On this final Sunday of the liturgical year, we celebrate Jesus as Lord of love, revealing God's love for all people and calling his followers to live in that love. In today's readings, we are reminded of the biblical imperative to care for the most vulnerable in society.

New Liturgical Year Begins on December 3, 2023

The new liturgical year begins with the First Sunday of Advent, December 3, 2023. We will begin doing some things differently at our liturgies to be more liturgically and theologically in accordance with the General Instruction of the Roman Missal. At all of our Masses, our hospitality ministers will be inviting you to come forward to receive Communion from our altar. This may take a little more time but it will provide us with the opportunity to all face the altar when receiving the Body and Blood of Christ. There will be two sets of ministers at the front of the altar for the reception of Communion. Our Extraordinary Ministers of Communion will come forward from their places at the Lamb of God. They will stand in front of the altar on the sanctuary and receive the Body of Christ from the Priest, and receive the Blood of Christ from the Deacon. They will then go forth and distribute the Body and Blood of Christ to all the faithful who are prepared to receive. The Choir and the area behind the altar (in front of the Retablo) will be receiving Communion from an additional minister. Those who have gathered in the area behind the altar, faithful and Altar Servers, will receive Communion after the Choir has received Communion. All of our Ministers (Extraordinary Ministers and Proclaimers of the Word) will come from the assembly to participate in their ministry. We will not have any reserved seating for them. They will be among the faithful who gather!


