# Father's Footnotes Fourth Sunday of Advent-December 24, 2023

### Christmas at San Fernando Cathedral & San Francesco di Paola

Christmas is very special at San Fernando Cathedral and San Francesco di Paola! Please note that since this year Christmas Day is tomorrow, Monday, the Fourth Sunday of Lent is shortened in order to begin the celebration of the Nativity of Jesus Christ, December 25th. Please note that you cannot fulfill your obligations to both the Fourth Sunday of Advent and Christmas at the same Mass. You would have to attend two Masses today to do so.

# San Fernando Cathedral

December 24

We celebrate the Fourth Sunday of Advent at the 8:00 AM (Spanish), 10:00 AM (English) and 12 Noon (Spanish) Masses. We celebrate Christmas at the 6 PM (English), 8 PM (Bilingual) and 12 Midnight Mass. We will begin a special Service of Christmas Carols at 11:00 PM (prior to the Midnight Mass).

Please note there is no 2 PM or 5 PM Mass today.

December 25

We will have two Masses at 10:00 AM and 12 Noon.

### San Francesco di Paola

December 24

We celebrate the Fourth Sunday of Advent at the 11:00 (English) AM and 1:30 PM (Spanish) Masses. We celebrate Christmas at the 4 PM (Bilingual) Mass.

December 25

We will have one Mass at 10:00 AM (English)

January 1 is the Solemnity of Mary, The Holy Mother of God. This solemnity is usually a holy day of obligation, but since it falls on a Monday the obligation to attend Mass is lifted. We will, however, have two Masses at San Fernando Cathedral on Monday, January 1, 2024 at 12:05 PM and 6:00 PM.


