



Only Beeswax Candles in Church, Please Devotional candles are important in our faith. Candles are symbols of the presence of Christ, the light of the world (Jn 8:12) and of Baptism by which we share in his light (Col 1:12), and are also signs of reverence and festivity. To protect the historic San Fernando Cathedral, we ask that only pure beeswax candles be burned to avoid noxious soot that other candles emit and that may harm the interior of the church. The candles we sell are 100% beeswax and safe to burn inside the Cathedral. Thank you for understanding!




