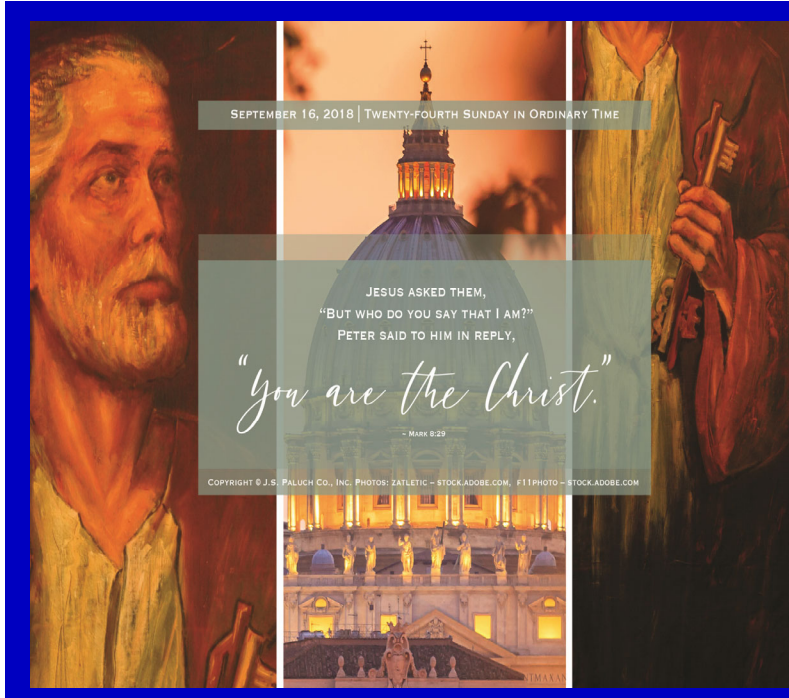

Welcome Fr. Carlos! We are happy to announce that Bishop McManus has appointed **Fr. Carlos Ruiz** as Administrator of Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish, effective October 1st.



Fr. Carlos is originally from Medellin, Colombia. He arrived in United States in 2011 and studied ESL program at Clark University in Worcester for two years. From 2013 to 2015 he attended St. Mary's Seminary and University in Baltimore, MD, where he received his bachelor's in Sacred Theology and his Master of Divinity degree. He was ordained as a priest by Bishop McManus on June 20, 2015. Fr. Carlos comes from Our Lady of the Lake Parish in Leominster, where he has been Associate Pastor these past three years. Father Carlos will begin his ministry here at Immaculate Heart of Mary on the weekend of September 29-30th.

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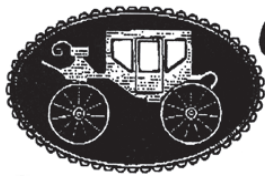


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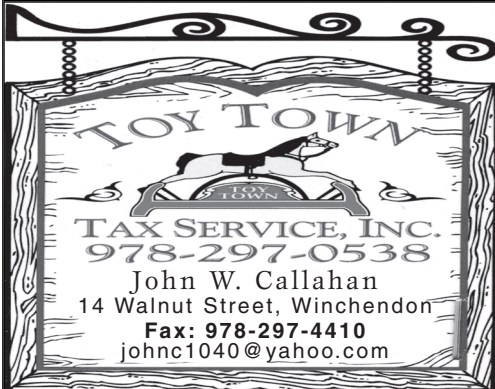
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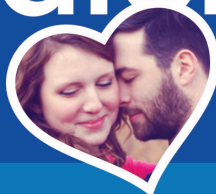
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
