My thanks to all of the wonderful folks in Blessed Trinity parish for the warm welcome that I received during my weekend visit. Letters keep coming in with donations for our work of saving souls and lives in St. Peter Parish, Nkololo and Songambele Hospital. The help is most welcome and necessary for continuing to develop our hospital. We have come a long ways but still have so far to go. We expect to have visitors sometime in 2019. I pray that we will have sufficient funds to make it possible to construct a facility for volunteers and hospital guests. We now have 68 hospital beds and with a lot of help we will add 30 private rooms, 14 beds in a children's ward and 14 beds in a men's ward. We continue to dream of having a school for training registered nurses. It would be a great boon for our community and for providing nursing care for our hospital. Many dreams have come true and I pray that this one will too. God Bless you all. ~ Fr. Paul
