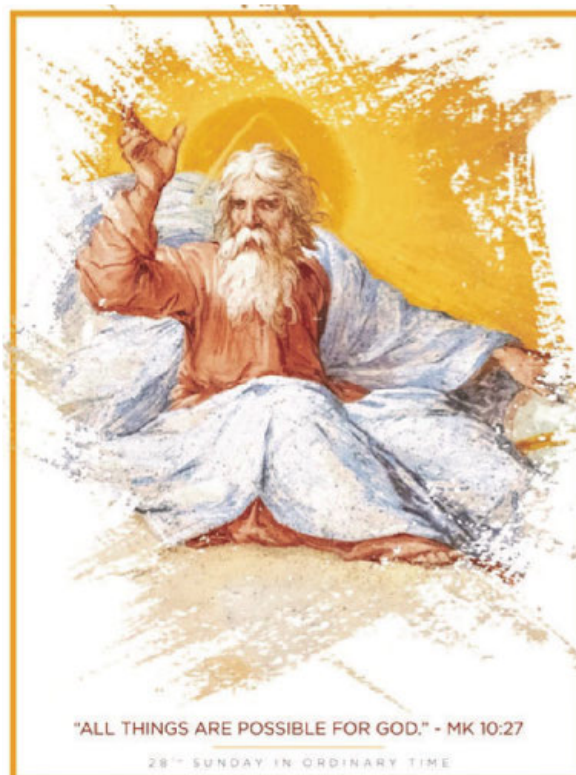

Notes from Father Joseph -

Fatima Statues: The outdoor statues of the Blessed Mother and the three shepherd children in Dane need to be worked on. In particular, they need to be cleaned and painted. Once finished, they will be erected

to the left of the St. Michael Church entrance. If you'd be willing to take on this project, please contact me (Fr. Joe). Hopefully this can get done before the frost so that they can be put up this year.

Raffle: Wow! Because of your generosity our Fall Festival Raffle netted over \$46,000 this year. I know that it can be difficult to sell tickets, but I appreciate your sacrifice making this fundraiser, the parish and school's single largest source of income, happen year after year.

Swiss Steak & Ham Dinner: We sold 982 Swiss Steak & Ham Dinners at this year's Fall Fest. Thank you again to Sharon Sellner for organizing and to our many hard-working volunteers.

Fish Fry: We're off to another great start. We sold 791 meals at our first Fish Fry of the season last Friday. Save the date for our next Fish Fry which will be on Friday, Nov. 5th. Once again drive-thru will be available from 4:30 until 7:00. See you then!

Statue Blessed: Bishop Hying celebrated the school Mass and blessed the new statue of St. Isidore on Friday. The statue was given to the parish in memory of Margaret Karls, and in honor of the Jim and Kay Kalscheur Family. If you haven't already, I encourage you to stop by Dane and see how beautiful it looks. It's a wonderful addition to St. Michael's and will be a saintly source of inspiration for years to come.

Holy Rosary: As we continue to pray the Rosary communally 25 minutes before each of the weekend Masses, I want to emphasize again the importance of praying together. As you know, UNITY is one of the four marks of the Church. While we might prefer praying faster or slower, praying together requires sacrifice and humility – the ability to sacrifice our own preferences and the humility to listen to others. I encourage you to make a conscious effort to make the UNITY of the Church manifest by praying the Rosary together.

Confession: Make Confession a priority! ***I challenge every family and every parishioner to make it to Confession at least once before the end of October.*** A reminder that the Sacrament of Confession is now available five times a week. Confessions are available Thursday evenings from 5:00 until 5:45 PM (Lodi), Friday afternoons from 1:30 until 2:15 PM (Dane), Saturday mornings from 9:00 until 10:00 AM (Dane), Saturday afternoons from 3:30 until 4:15 PM (Lodi), and Sunday mornings from 7:30 until 7:45 AM (Dane). Confession is good spiritual hygiene for the soul. Like taking a shower, it's something we never outgrow, even if we become the saints God created us to be. So if it's been a number of years, or even if it's only been a couple weeks, come enjoy God's mercy.

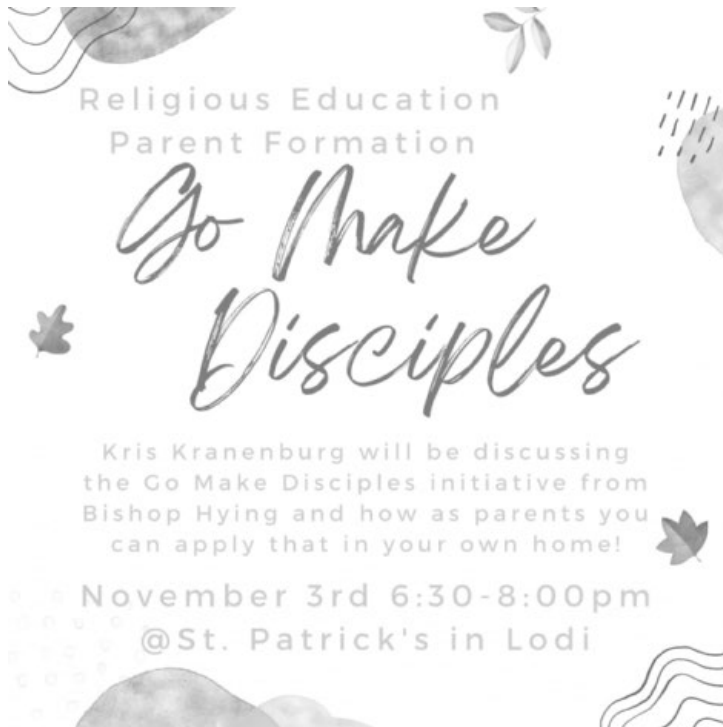
