Notes from Father Joseph -

Last weekend an important announcement was made regarding *Into the Deep*, our parish, and new priest assignments. In an effort to realign our resources so that we can better accomplish and live out our mission, Bishop Hying approved a plan to group our current 102 parishes in the Diocese of Madison into 30 "pastorates" (which in time will become 30 new parishes).

Bishop Hying has assigned our parish to be in Pastorate 18 in the final approved model, which will take effect on **July 1, 2023**. Besides Blessed Trinity in Lodi and Dane, the other parishes in Pastorate 18 in the final approved model are St. John the Baptist in Waunakee and St. Mary of the Lake in Westport.

Regarding priest assignments, Bishop Hying has assigned the following priests to serve the parishes of this new pastorate: Leading Pastorate 18 as Parochial Administrator will be Fr. Joseph Baker. Assisting with pastoral work and serving as Parochial Vicars will be Fr. Enan Zelinski and Dcn. Simon Tipps (who will be ordained a priest this spring).

Did You Know.....

St. Patrick was born and baptized as Maewyn Succat, in Roman Britain between 385 and 392 to a Christian family. At the age of 15 or 16, he was kidnapped by a handful of Irish pirates who took him with them to Northern Ireland and sold him as a slave. After 6 years of imprisonment, Patrick had in a dream a premonition of freedom, and, obeying the sight he had as he slept, escaped surveillance & went the roughly 200 km that separated him from the coast, on foot. He was able to induce some sailors to have pity on him, who took him aboard their ship & carried him back to Britain where he could embrace his family once again.

On an unknown date between 431 & 423, Patrick was consecrated Bishop of Ireland by Pope Celestine 1 and arrived in Slane on March 25, 432. He found himself faced with countless difficulties: The chief of one of the Drude tribes tried to kill him, and for 60 days he was imprisoned, but despite the tribulations, Patrick persisted nearly forty years in his missionary work, converting thousands of Irish, introducing monastic life, and establishing the episcopal see in Armagh. According to tradition, St. Patrick used to explain the mystery of the Trinity by showing the clover, in which three leaflets are joined at a single stem. His Feast Day is March 17th.
