With All Souls' Days on November 2<sup>nd</sup>, the Church begins a month dedicated to praying for the dead. This is a great reminder that each of us should make and write down plans for a Catholic funeral. And it is a great opportunity to discuss the funeral policies of our Pastorate. Given the number of funerals in our Pastorate, it was a priority to establish normative ways of navigating the planning process. Most of these policies come directly from the *Order of Christian Funerals*, the Catholic Church's ritual book for such liturgies.

As a rule, Catholic funerals are celebrated in one of the Pastorate's churches – St. Patrick, St. Michael, St. John the Baptist, or St. Mary of the Lake. As a public rite, all members of the parish are invited to participate in a funeral. The standard liturgy for a deceased Catholic who was in good standing with the Church is a Mass of Christian Burial with the body present. A Mass should always be the presumed format. If there is a question about whether a liturgy without Mass might be more appropriate, the family should speak with one of the Pastorate's priests. When Mass is celebrated, during Holy Communion, those practicing Catholics who are properly disposed, in a state of grace, and who have fasted for one hour may come forward to receive Jesus Christ in the Blessed Sacrament. All others will be asked to remain prayerfully in their place.

The grieving process necessarily includes time to remember the life of the deceased loved one. In the Catholic funeral rite, this is most appropriately done during the time of visitation or at a luncheon. Since the funeral liturgy is primarily a time of prayer, diocesan policy forbids the inclusion of a eulogy during these rites.

During visitations and before Mass, the faithful are encouraged to do their best to help maintain the sacredness of the church. While individuals are welcome to use the church for prayer, the atmosphere should always be one of silent recollection. Conversation should take place outside of the church (e.g., in the narthex, parish hall, etc.).

Pastorate 18 is happy to provide a musician/cantor for funeral liturgies. If a family wishes to have a specific accompanist, cantor, or choir from the Pastorate, this should be communicated to the priest coordinating the funeral as soon as possible. Because the Mass is a public act of worship of the Church, the priest is ultimately responsible for the music in the funeral liturgy. While many secular songs may have special meaning to a loved one, family, or friends, they are rarely appropriate for liturgical use in the Catholic Church and should therefore be reserved for gatherings before or after the funeral liturgy and burial. During the funeral liturgy planning meeting, the priest can help families choose music appropriate for the funeral Mass. Use of recorded music in the liturgy is not permitted.

While already worn at some of our churches, black vestments will be utilized throughout the Pastorate for funerals. Black, with its echoes of mourning and reserve, both acknowledges our own emotional response to the loss of a loved one, and is further representative of our need to pray for the repose of our loved one's soul. This somber recognition is balanced by the white funeral pall which recalls the white garment given to us at Baptism, representing the hope and new life given to us by Christ's resurrection.

Throughout the centuries, the Church has followed the practice of inhumation after the pattern of Christ's own burial. This expresses respect for the human body as a member of Christ and faith in the resurrection of the body. Although the cremation of remains is not forbidden, it is still preferred that the physical body of the deceased be present during the funeral liturgy. When cremation does occur, remains should never be scattered or divided among family members. The cremated remains of one deceased person may not be mixed with the cremated remains of another person. It is not permitted to delay the burial of the cremated remains in anticipation of the eventual burial of another person. The permanent storage of cremated remains in a private home, funeral home, or any other place is prohibited.

Hopefully these policies provide clarity and consistency in our Pastorate. If you would like a complete copy of the Pastorate's funeral policies, please feel to reach out to the parish office.
